TPB SR1-2022 and TPB SR2-2022: to approve projects for funding under the Federal Transportation Alternatives Set Aside Program for the District of Columbia and Suburban Maryland for FY 2022.

2. REVIEW AND RECOMMEND FOR TPB APPROVAL ON JULY 21, 2021, A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE FY 2021-2024 TIP

Mark Phillips, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA)

TPB R2-2022: an amendment to update project description and funding information for FY 2022 for 13 project groupings in the FY 2021-2024 TIP to match WMATA's FY2022 Capital Budget adopted by the WMATA board on April 22, 2021. The proposed amendment adds \$659.3 million in funding to FY 2022 and to the four-year total of the program, increasing it from \$6.731 billion to \$7.391 billion. The projects and programs included in the amendment are included in the Air Quality Conformity Analysis of the 2020 Amendment to Visualize 2045 and the FY 2021-2024 TIP or are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement.
