- **Adaptation and Resiliency Services**

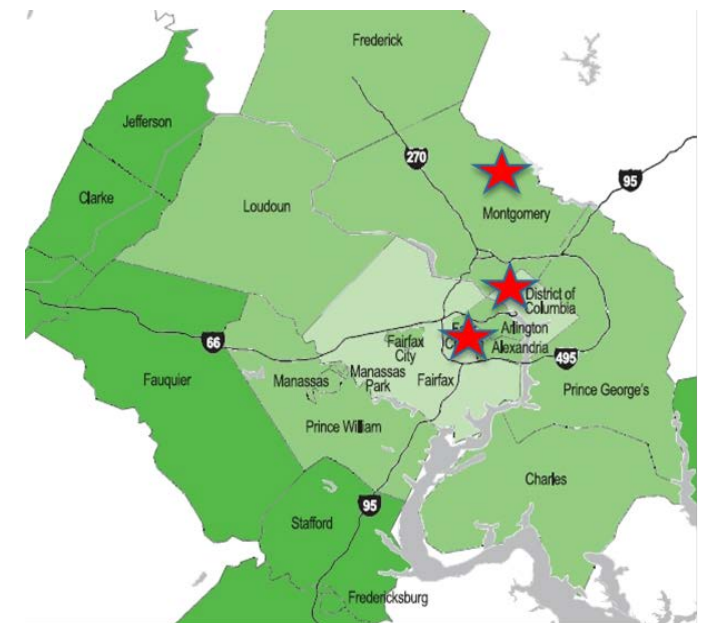

ICF Project Examples – MWCOG Region

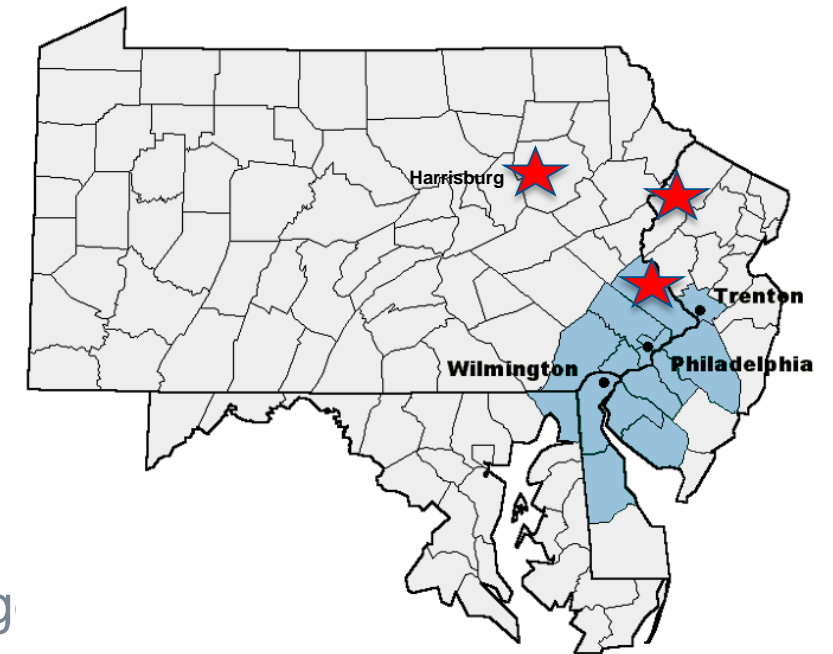
- **Arlington County Community Energy Plan:**
 - Technical recalibration of Plan to assess progress and potential reductions strategies to meet GHG goals; modeling impacts of 5 key strategies
- **Montgomery County Energy Policy:**
 - Detailed analysis of the county’s commercial buildings energy policy to support its Climate Action Plan
- **MWCOG Climate Action:**
 - GHG modeling, energy and built environment analysis and planning, and renewable energy
- **EnergySmart D.C (NSpireGreen).:**
 - Communications expertise for D.C.’s Comprehensive Energy Plan through technical research and writing, data collection, modeling, developing a carbon footprint, and recommending future EE strategies

ICF Project Examples – Philadelphia Area

- **Pennsylvania State Climate Action Plan:**
 - Update to state’s Climate Action Plan and Energy Assessment
- **Philadelphia Energy Master Plan:**
 - Energy Master Plan for the Built Environment
 - 80 by 50 GHG reduction analysis
 - GHG Inventories
 - Adaptation and Resilience Assessments and Strategies (Growing Strong)
 - One-off energy assessments (e.g., CPACE)
 - Sustainability metrics and scoring
 - Government and Community outreach
- **Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission:**
 - GHG inventory and forecast to develop a regional climate change strategy
