Re: Preliminary Schedule for Round 8.3 Cooperative Forecast

The Draft Round 8.2 Cooperative Forecast is scheduled to be adopted by the COG Board of Directors at their July 2013 meeting. For jurisdictions that are interested in making changes to Round 8.2, this fall will be the first opportunity to revise their forecast. The schedule for Round 8.3 will be similar to Round 8.2 with an accelerated schedule to approve both the control totals and submit the TAZ level data in early 2014. Once again, Round 8.3 *is voluntary* and some jurisdictions may choose not to make any changes or to make changes only to the population, households, or employment data.

The Round 8.3 schedule could be the following:

September 2013

September 10th Local jurisdictions will submit a Letter of Intent (from the Planning Director) outlining changes (Employment, Population, and Households) to their Cooperative Forecasting data.

October 2013

October 1st Preliminary local jurisdictional totals (Control Totals) are due to COG Staff by the October Cooperative Forecasting Meeting.

October 18th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

November 2013

November 5th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Cooperative Forecasting Committee.

November 15th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

December 2013

December 3rd Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Cooperative Forecasting Committee.

December 20th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

January 2014

January 17th Final Local jurisdictional totals are approved by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

February 2014

Round 8.3 TAZ level forecast are due to COG staff by February 1, 2014.

February 12th COG Board approves Round 8.3 as inputs for TPB's Air Quality Conformity Analysis.

Mid-February 2014

TAZ level forecasts are transmitted to Transportation Planning Staff.

July 2014

July - COG Board Adopts Round 8.3 Forecasts
