What is Capital Bikeshare?

- Metro DC area's **publicly owned, non-profit bikeshare service**
- Designed for quick and convenient trips
- 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Over 6,000 Capital Bikeshare bikes and 780 bikeshare docking stations located across 8 jurisdictions:

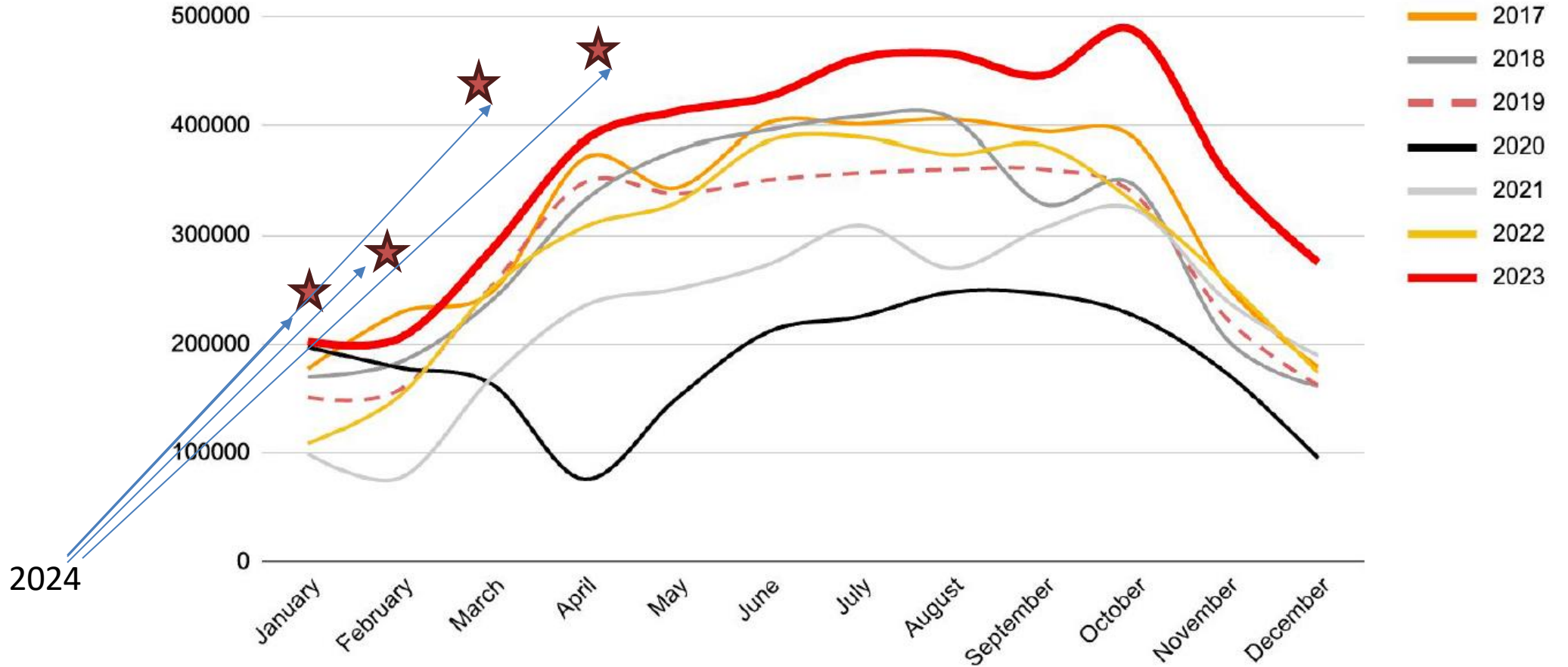

- Alexandria, VA
- Prince George's County, MD
- Fairfax County, VA
- Montgomery County, MD
- Falls Church, VA
- City of Fairfax, VA

What is Capital Bikeshare?

- Launched in September 2010
- First citywide bikesharing system in the country
- Over 39 million trips have been taken by Capital Bikeshare bikes
- Over 28,000 monthly or annual members
- 2023 was best year ever – 4,426,431 trips

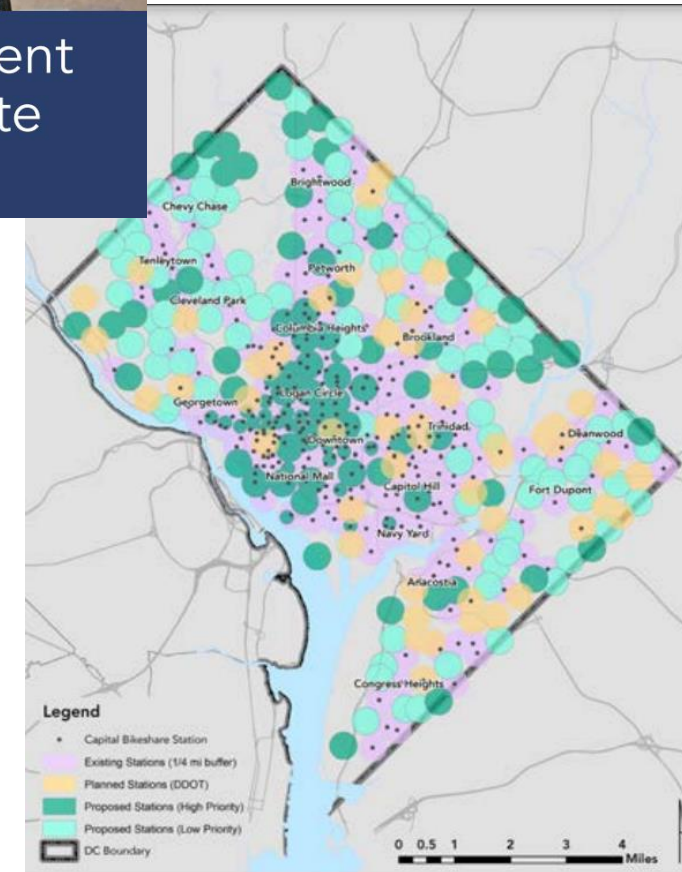

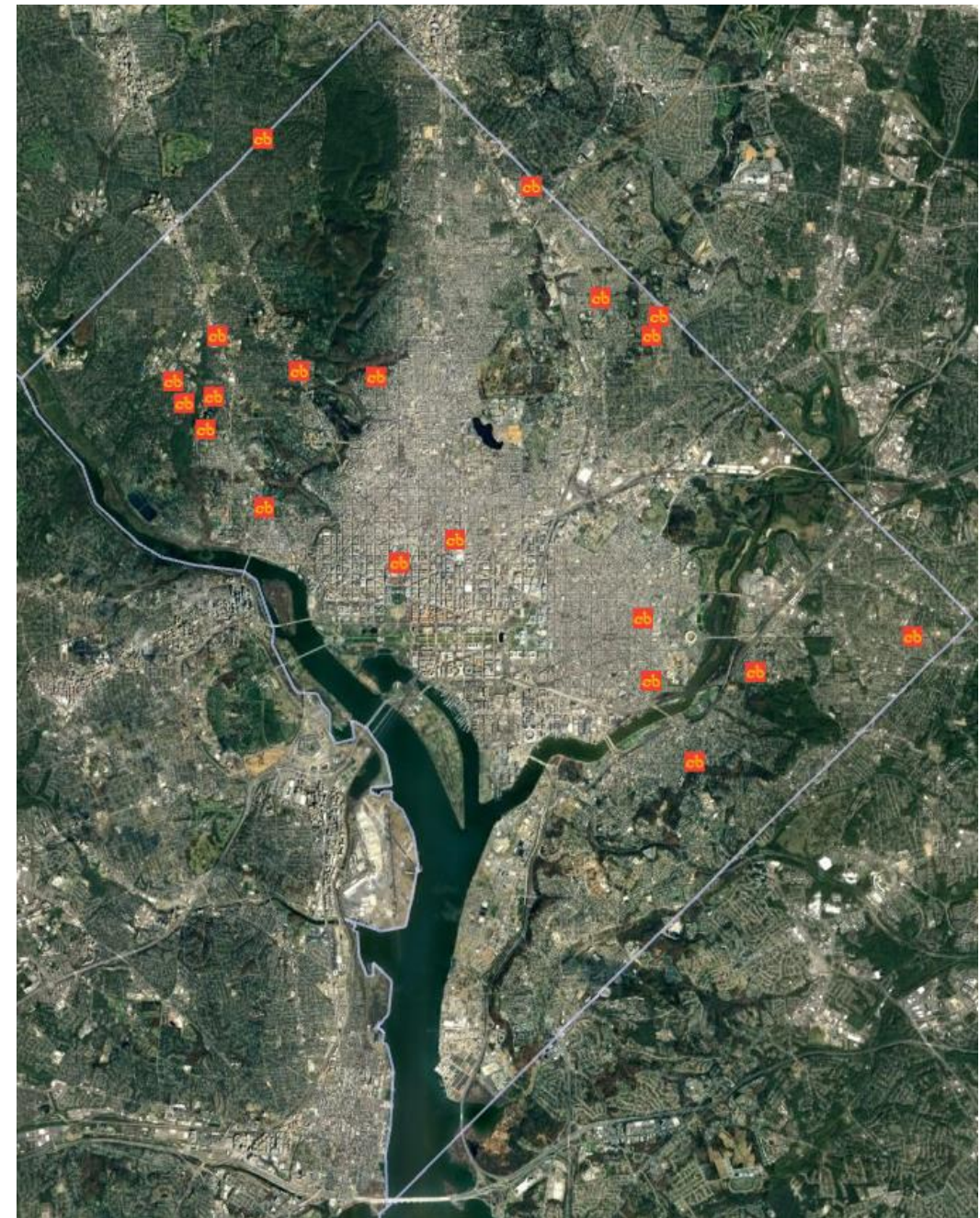
System Expansion

- Revenue
- Ridership
- Access
- moveDC
 - 90% of District \leq 1/4 mile
 - ~20 new stations per year



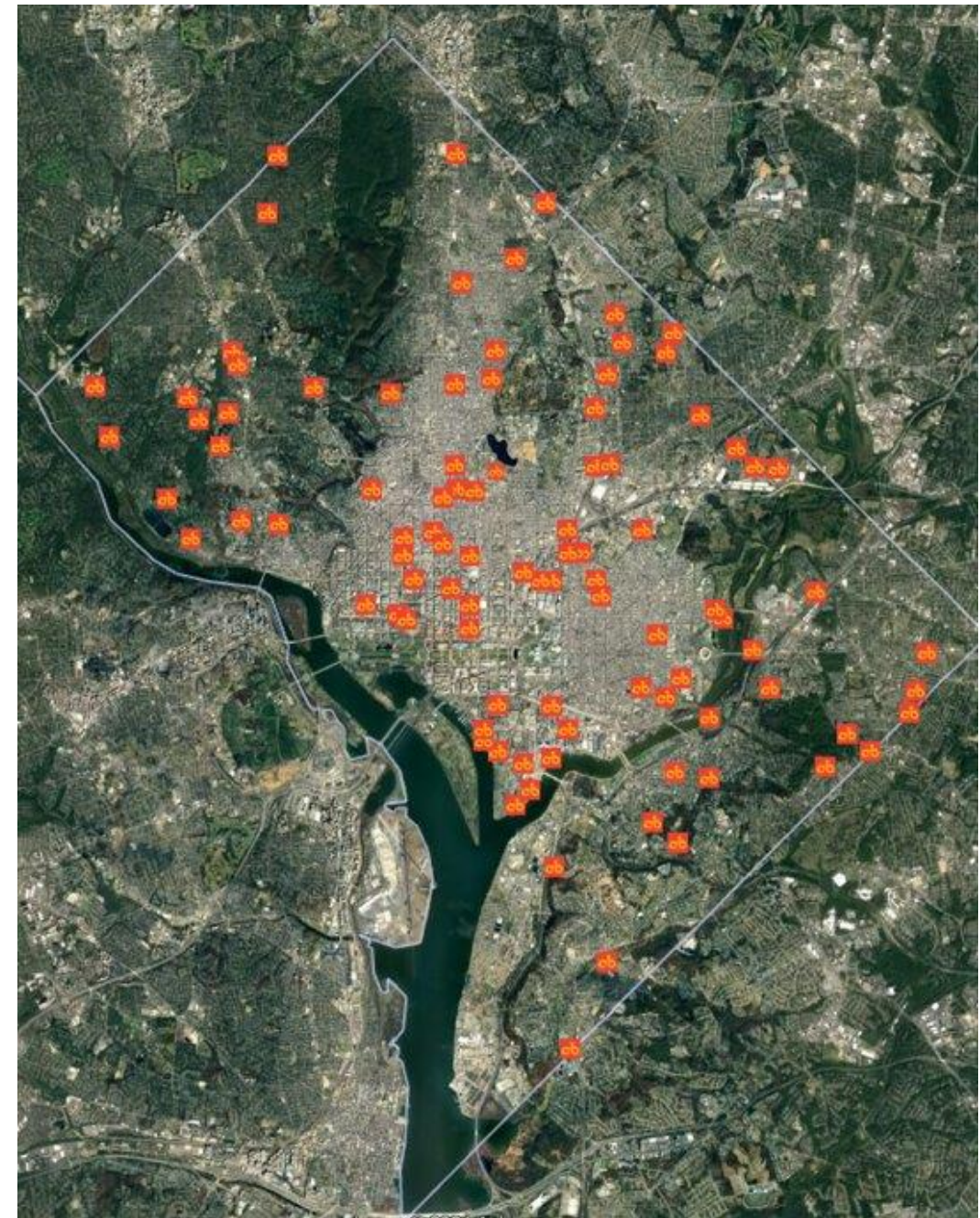

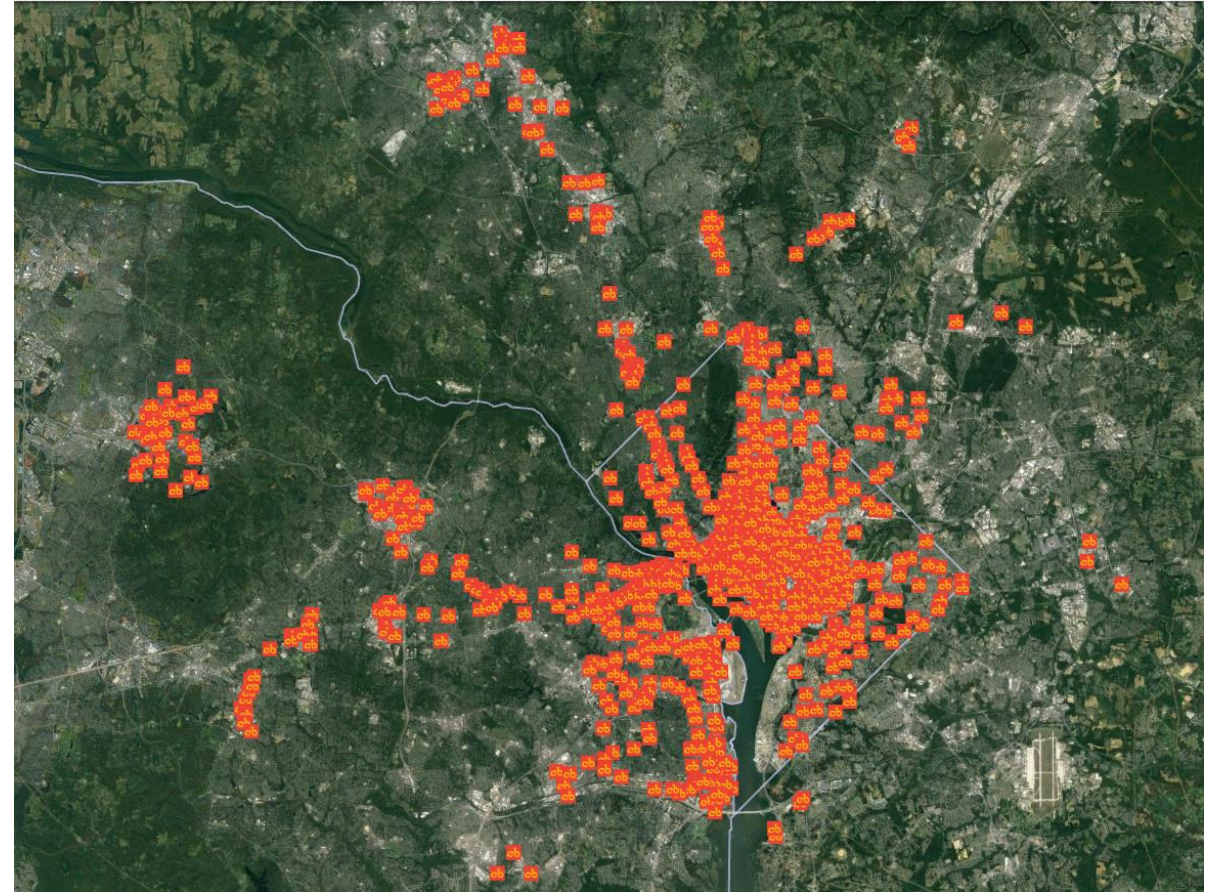

State of Good Repair

State of Good Repair

- Replace stations > 10 years old
 - 189 stations
 - 95 replaced – 84% of original stations
- Expand where possible
- Prioritize:
 - Ridership
 - Operations
 - Aesthetics
 - Expansion
 - Efficiency

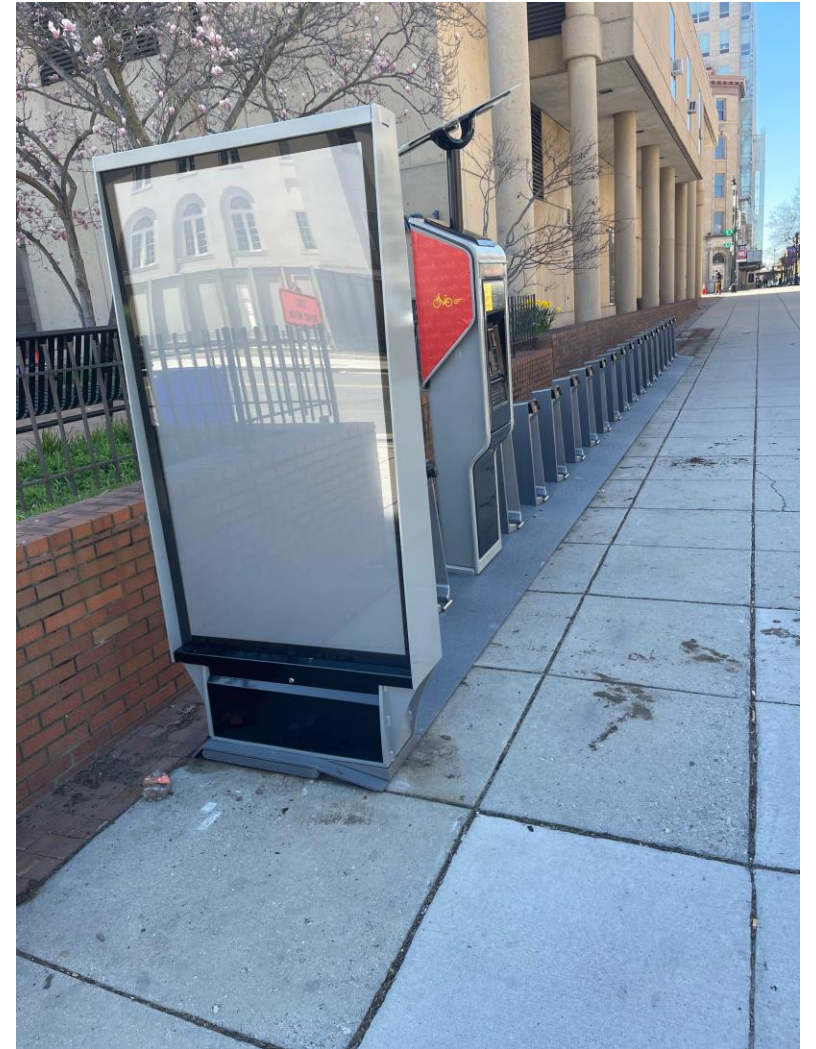
Lincoln Park / 13th & East Capitol St NE

>416,000 total trips
Expanded from 25 --> 33 docks



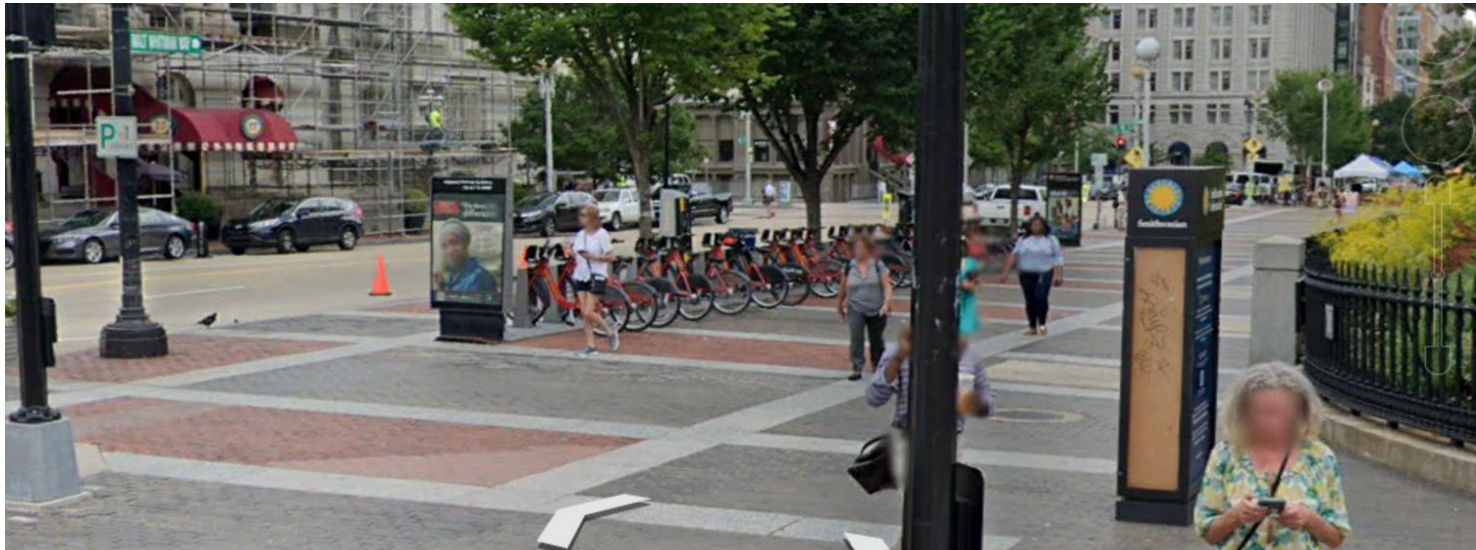
5th & F St NW



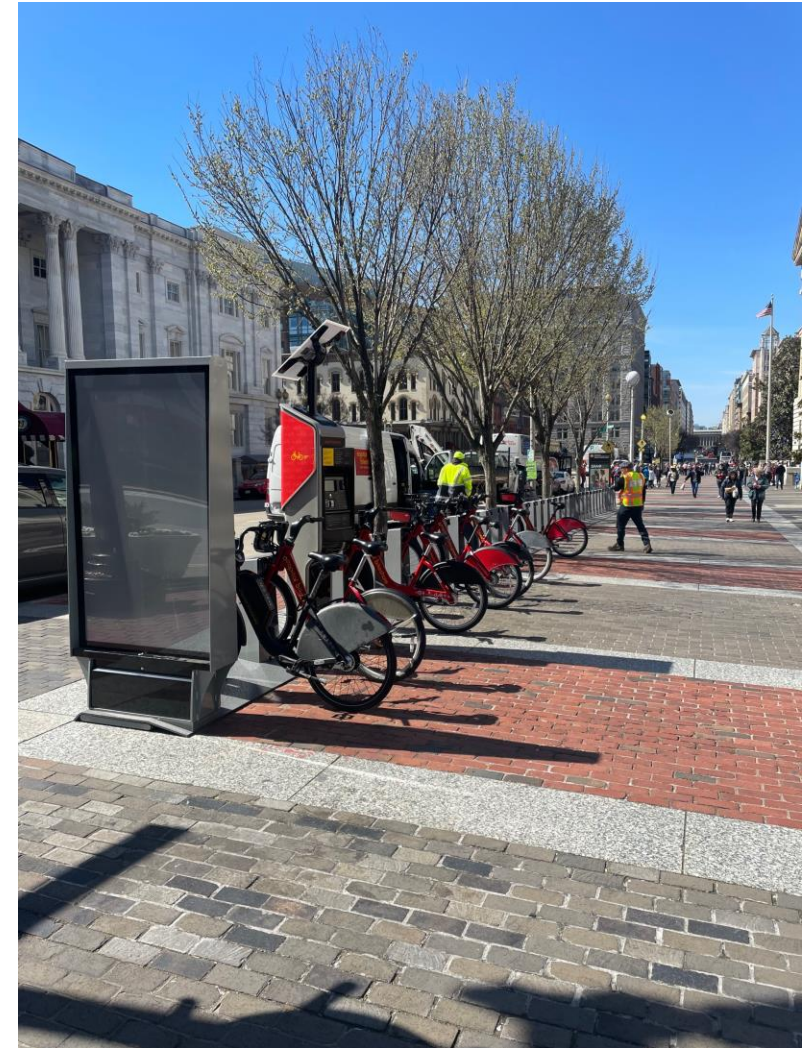
- Installed October 2010
- >330,000 total trips



7th & F St NW / National Portrait Gallery



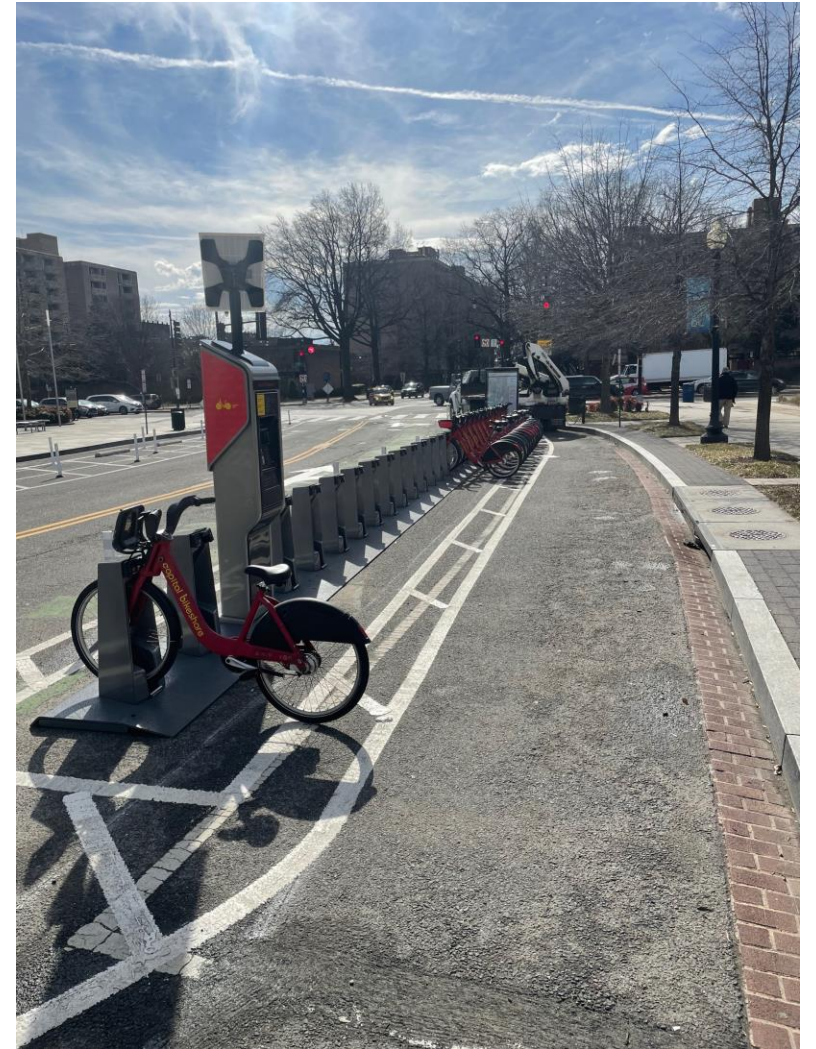
- Installed April 2011
- >526,000 total trips
- 18th most popular station
- 27 → 35 docks



4th & M St SW



- Installed September 2010
- >485,000 total trips
- 24th most popular station
- 23 → 27 docks





Ebikes

Ebikes

- Adding more and more
 - ~600 older ebikes in field
 - ~1500 new model deployed FY23
 - 1000 more deploying over next few months
- Longer range
- Better visibility
- More durable



Reliability

- Return of downtown weekday commuter valets in April
 - 13th St & New York Ave NW
 - 20th & L St NW
- Weekend valets
 - C & O Canal & Wisconsin Ave NW
 - 9th St & Maine Ave SW
- Better rebalancing
- In-dock charging
