Federal Transit Administration (FTA)

Enhanced Mobility Program

- COG is the Designated Recipient for the Washington DC-VA-MD Urbanized Area
- Unique role for TPB: Prioritizes, selects and implements projects
- Approximately \$2.8 million per year in matching grants to improve transportation for people with disabilities and older adults
- Matching funds required
 - 20% for Capital or Mobility Management
 - 50% for Operating



Solicitation Basics

- August 14 through November 3, 2017
- Approximately \$6 million in federal funding available
- Priority projects confirmed by the AFA
- Five pre-application conferences held
- Promoted through TPBNews, social media and the Senior Beacon







Summary and Next Steps

- 17 recommendations would expend approximately \$6 million in Enhanced Mobility funds
- With the matching funds, the projects total nearly \$8 million
- Applicants with projects not recommended for funding will receive a letter with recommendations for improvement
- Following TPB approval and TIP amendment, TPB staff will submit projects to FTA for final approval
- Next Solicitation: Summer 2019


