What the Transportation Bill Means for Freight

As the deadline approached, the House and Senate moved ahead and passed HR. 4348, a two-year transportation bill on Friday June 29th. The Bill is now awaiting an anticipated Presidential signature.

What does the Transportation Bill Mean for Freight?

- National Freight Policy-Requires US DOT to designate national freight network, prepare a national freight strategic plan
 - Prioritization of Projects that Improve Freight Movement-Increases fed \$ for freight mobility projects identified in state freight plans
 - State Freight Plans
 - State Freight Advisory Committees
 - Increases Transportation Infrastructure Finance (TIFIA) loans from \$122M to \$750M
 - Commercial Motor Vehicle registration and Safety Requirements
 - Registration of Freight Forwarders and Shippers
