RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE FY 2020 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, the Statewide and Metropolitan Transportation Planning rule as published in the May 27, 2016 Federal Register by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) require a Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for Transportation Planning; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Planning Work Program is required as a basis and condition for all funding assistance for transportation planning to state, local and regional agencies by the FTA and FHWA; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2019 Unified Planning Work Program for Transportation Planning for the Washington Metropolitan Region was approved by the Transportation Planning Board (TPB) on March 23, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2019, the TPB released the draft FY 2020 UPWP for public comment; and

WHEREAS, the TPB had the opportunity to review the outline and budget on January 16, 2019 and the draft document on February 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the TPB Technical Committee reviewed the outline and budget on January 4, 2019 and the draft document on February 1, 2019, and recommended approval by the TPB of the final draft FY 2020 UPWP at its meeting on March 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2019, the TPB adopted resolution R14-2019 which identifies certain work activities and budgets for carryover funding from FY 2019 to FY 2020, and these work activities and budgets are incorporated into the final version of the FY 2020 UPWP;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board approves the FY 2020 Unified Planning Work Program for Transportation Planning for the Metropolitan Washington Region.
