 - Evaluate potential for expanding existing controls to upwind counties



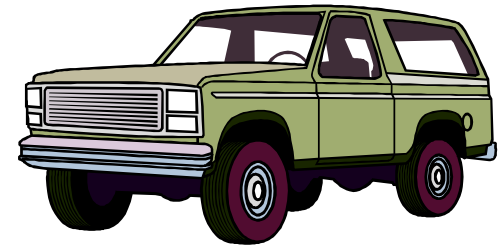
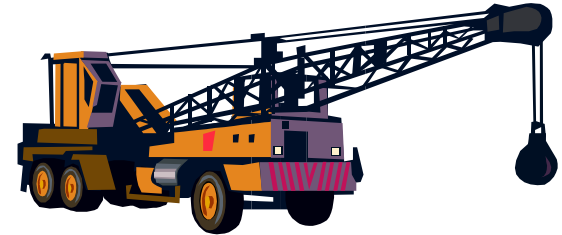
Screening Criteria

- Air Quality Benefit



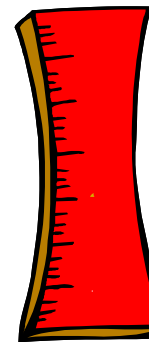
Priority Measures (draft list)

- Stationary Source Controls
- Expand Controls to Upwind Counties
- Control Small NO_x Sources
- Control Federally Preempted Sources
- State and Local Government Initiatives
- Control On-road Sources
