## Food Security

# \$4.05 million to combat senior food insecurity/social isolation

- iPads for homebound seniors receiving meal delivery
- Grocery gift card pilot for low-income seniors
- Fresh produce and nutrition support for seniors

\$4.4 million Equitable Healthy Food Access Grants

• Produce Plus, Healthy Corners, Joyful Food Markets, Home Delivered Meals

\$13.5 million to expand summer camps

• Will increase participation/access to summer meal program



## Stronger Local Food System

## \$19 million for Food Access Fund

\$500K for Nourish DC

\$200K Feasibility and Siting Study for a Centralized Food Processing Facility

2 new FTEs to expand the Office of Planning Food Policy Division



## Environment

### \$4.4 million for curbside composting pilot

#### \$800K for commercial on-site composting

\$1.6 million for farming/cooking/nutrition education programs in schools

\$500K Community farm at Oxon Run Park, Ward 8
