Requirement for a CMP

- A Congestion Management Process (CMP) is a requirement in metropolitan transportation planning
 - Many generations of federal regulations for metropolitan planning have addressed CMP requirements
 - FAST Act retained these CMP requirements
 - Added an option for a Congestion Management Plan that TMAs could pursue – may be considered in the future
- The official CMP component is integrated into the overall long-range transportation plan to address this requirement



The Series of CMP Technical Reports

- CMP Technical Reports were released in 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016, 2018 and 2020 under development
- 2010, 2014 and 2019 Federal Certification of the TPB Process commended the CMP for its detailed documentation efforts in the CMP Technical Reports
- Elements of the 2018 CMP Technical Report under CC purview are made available for review.
