

Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility Program

Goal: "Improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities....by removing barriers to transportation services and expanding the transportation mobility options available"

- \$2.8 million annually in Federal \$
- Solicitation for 2 years of funding
- Match:
 - o 50/50 Operating
 - 80/20 Capital and Mobility Management

FTA Requirements Enhanced Mobility Program

- Final Circular published 6/6/14 C 9070.1G
- Projects must be included in a Coordinated Human
 Service Transportation Plan "priorities for implementation"
- The project must end or begin in the Washington DC-VA-MD Urbanized Area
- Limited Project eligibility and recipients
 - At least 55% Capital Projects for Private Non-Profit or a State or Local Governments that meet certain conditions ("traditional" 5310)
 - Remaining 45% Non-Profits, Private operators, State or local governments, Transit operators
- Additional reporting and administrative requirements
 - e.g. Ridership, asset conditions, vehicle inventories, procurement,
 Title VI and DBE

Priority Projects

- 12 priorities developed by HSTC Task Force and AFA Committee to respond to strategies for addressing unmet transportation needs
- Region would like to see applications that respond to priorities, however:
 - Applicants can propose other projects
 - Project selection is dependent on applications received
 - Not weighted more heavily than other project proposals

Priority Projects

- Of the 12 priorities, the following are applicable for bus operators:
 - Coordination Planning Efforts
 - Travel Training
 - Shuttles or Taxis to Address "last mile" problems
 - Driver Training Customer Service and Sensitivity
 - Bus Stop and Sidewalk Improvements
 - Deviated Bus or Feeder Service for Targeted area or Population Groups

Solicitation

- Mid-August with a mid-October application deadline
- Pre-application conferences will be held in MD, VA, DC
- Solicitation for \$5 million in Federal Funds
- 2- year projects
- On-line application
- Recommending:
 - Minimum request of \$250,000 over 2 years
 - No in-kind match

Project Selection

- Independent Selection Committee chaired by HSTC Task Force Chair:
 - Local human service and transit representatives
 - National organizations with expertise in transportation for people with disabilities and older adults
- Reviews and scores applications
- Makes funding Recommendations to TPB
- TPB asked to approve Recommendations

Selection Criteria Maximum Points: 100

- Responsiveness to Coordinated Plan -20
- Coordination Among Agencies -25
- Institutional Capacity to Manage & Administer an FTA grant -20
- Project Feasibility- 15
- Regional Need (serves more than one jurisdiction)- 10
- Customer Focus -10
