As proposed, CapCom will provide regionwide coordination and communications during incidents affecting transportation, including during major emergencies. Following the April committee meeting, CAC Chair Dennis Jaffe sent a letter to key transportation officials asking if they support the establishment of CapCom, and if so, asking those officials to move expeditiously to fund and implement the program. The CAC will discuss next steps.
