- Adopt TPB SR24-2024 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 23-39.3 which adds the Envision Route 7 Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Planning Study (T13608) and increases funding for the Crystal City Metro Station East Entrance (T6670), as requested by the Virgina Department of Rail and Public Transportation.
