On the books



- Area source sector VOC controls
- •EGUs de-commissioned in 2012 Title V permit condition (Regional Haze SIP)
- CAIR FIP
- NOx SIP Call (non-EGUs)
- •EERE measures (energy benchmarking regulation; Renewable Energy Incentive Program; etc.)



In the works



- •Ultra low sulfur fuel oil rule
- Nonroad idling rule
- •LEV revisions (if Tier 3 national rule gets delayed)
- Additional VOC rule revisions
- •The District's *Sustainable DC* building and transportation actions (DC Streetcars, DC Circulator, Capital Bikeshare, expansion of bike network, etc.)



Being evaluated



- Stationary generators (& HEDD)
- Aftermarket catalysts OTC model rule
- •ULNBs? (controls for small natural gas-fired ICI boilers, steam generators, process heaters, and water heaters)
- •CHP?
- Off-road diesel (construction equipment?)
- •I/M Program revisions (Diesel OBD and heavy duty gasoline I/M)



Other efforts



- Capitol Power Plant-wide Applicability Limit
 (PAL) permit Proposed
- •Air Toxics regulation (to consider RICE rule, boiler MACT)
- GHG Tailoring Rule
- DERA and ARRA engine replacements/retrofits
- Enhanced enforcement of the District's antiidling regulations
- Comprehensive Energy Planning
