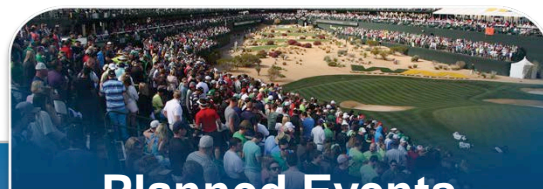



42nd Marine Corps Marathon

The Marathon starts with the blast of the M2A1 Howitzer at 7:55 a.m., sending runners on a mission to 'charge the district, beat the bridge and take the Iwo'. Wheelchair and hand cycle participants will begin at 7:55 a.m. The MCM start line is located on Route 110 (all lanes) halfway between the Pentagon and Arlington Memorial Drive.

The Metro will open at 6 a.m. on Marathon Day. The closest Metro access to the start is the Pentagon station (blue/yellow). Arlington Cemetery Station is the only station that will remain closed on Marathon morning until 8:30 a.m.

Runners Village

Located in the Pentagon North Parking lot, Runners Village presented by Hyundai is the official launching pad for MCM participants. Runners may access Runners Village by MCM shuttles from Crystal City, or the Pentagon Metro Station (blue/yellow). Essential pre-start support is provided to runners including the MCM Info Tent, numerous port-a-johns, UPS Baggage Drop-off, prayer services starting at 6 a.m. and 6:45 a.m., a water station and motivating music and announcements. 
