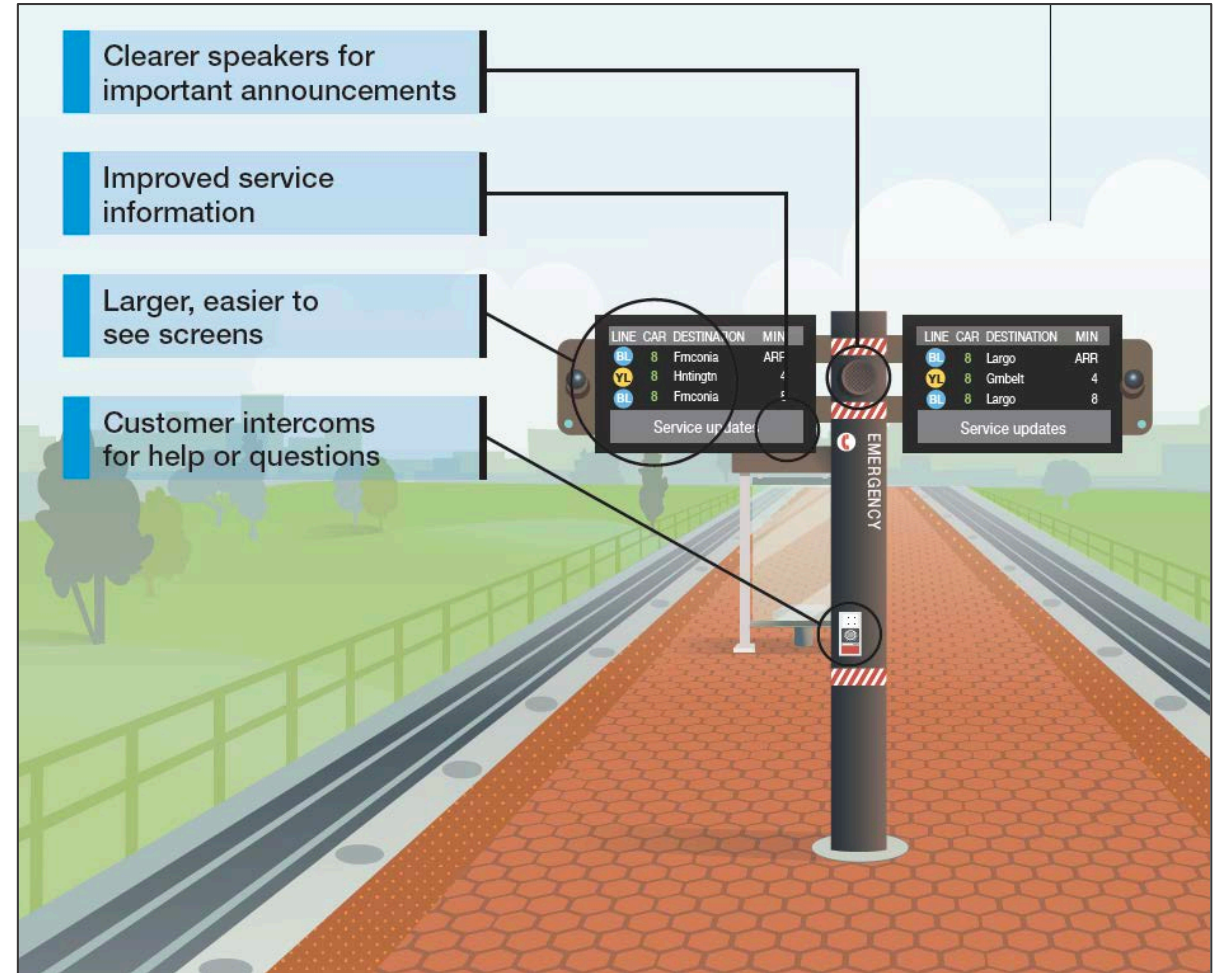
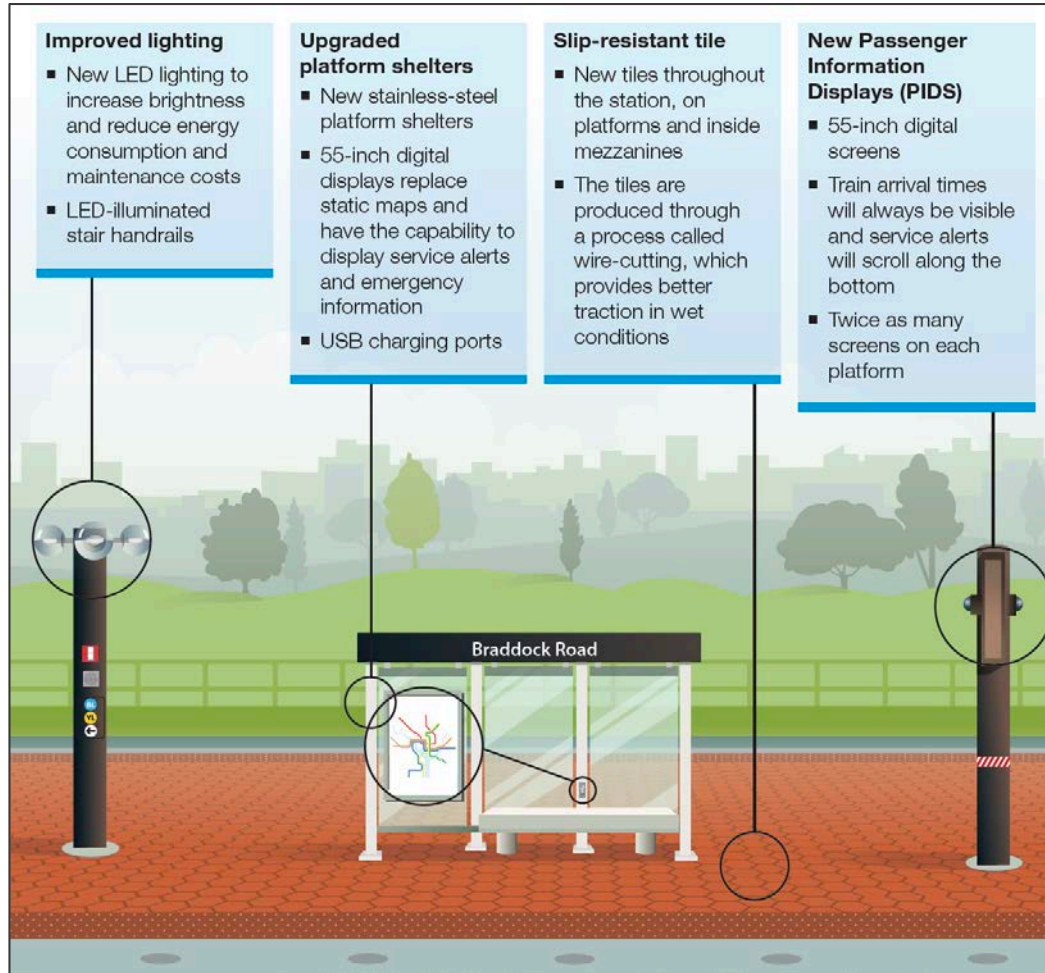


State of the Platforms

- Concrete platforms have been exposed to weather and de-icing agents for decades
- Platforms built 35-40 years ago are now deteriorating
- Necessary for safety and accessibility
- 50% of overall project completed

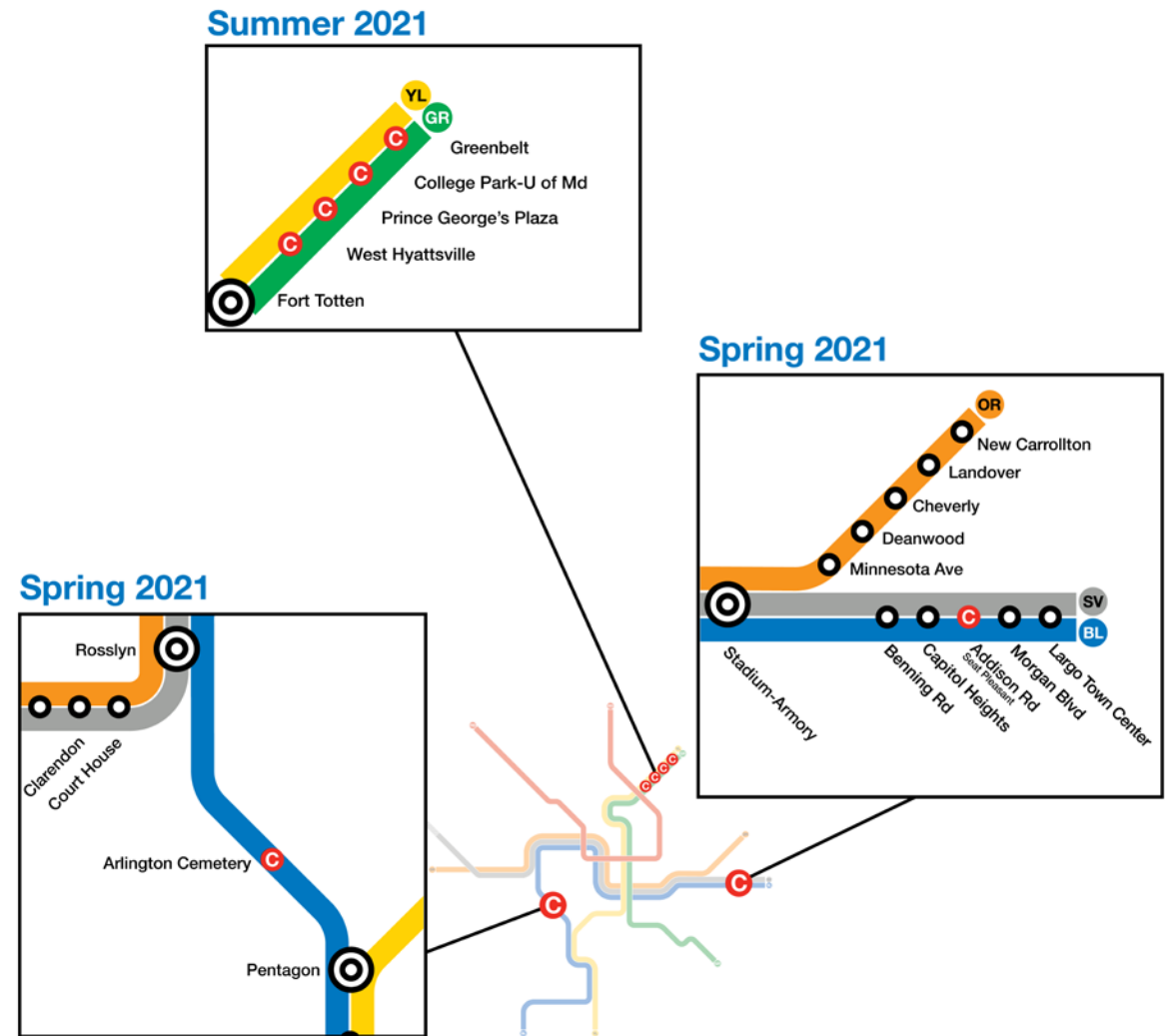

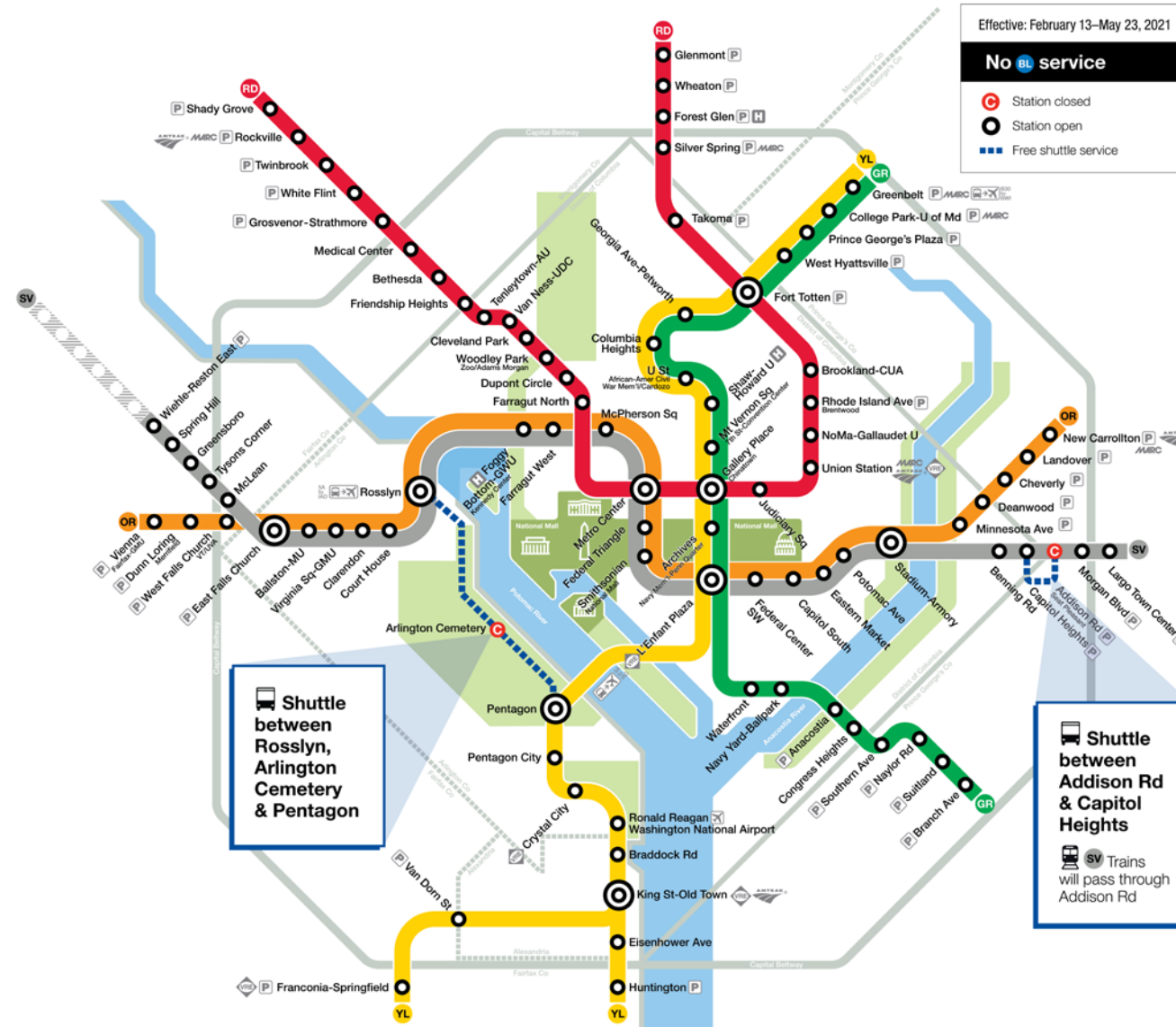


Station Closures — 2021

- February 13 — May 23
 - **BL** **SV** Addison Rd
 - **BL** Arlington Cemetery
- May 29 — September 6
 - **YL** **GR** Greenbelt
 - **YL** **GR** College Park-U of Md
 - **YL** **GR** Prince George's Plaza
 - **YL** **GR** West Hyattsville

Rail Service Information

- **BL** service temporarily suspended
- **YL** service between Franconia-Springfield & Mt Vernon Sq and between Huntington & Greenbelt
- **SV** single tracking through Addison Rd at near normal levels
- Riders traveling between stations in Virginia, south of Arlington Cemetery to Downtown DC, should take **YL** and transfer at L'Enfant Plaza to **OR** **SV**
- Riders travelling between Largo Town Center and Rosslyn stations should use **SV**

Free Shuttle Service Information

- Between **Addison Rd & Capitol Heights**
 - Every 6-10 minutes
- Between **Rosslyn, Arlington Cemetery & Pentagon**
 - Only serving Arlington Cemetery during hours the rail station is open (7 p.m. until March 31 and 10 p.m. beginning April 1)
 - After Arlington Cemetery Station closes, shuttles will continue to operate between Rosslyn and Pentagon stations only
 - Every 12-15 minutes
- Operate all hours the rail system is open

Additional Information

■ Construction

- Prior to, during, and after the station closures, customers will experience pedestrian detours, parking closures and weekend shutdowns while crews stage equipment and materials

■ Parking

- Addison Rd will be free for the duration of the station closures
- Regular fares will be charged at all other stations

■ Accessibility

- All shuttles will be accessible and operated by Metrobus
