Schedule for Round 8.4

September 2014

September 9th Local jurisdictions notify COG staff of the intent to make changes (Employment, Population, and Households) to their Cooperative Forecasting data.

October 2014

Preliminary local jurisdictional totals (Benchmark Totals) are due to COG Staff by the end of October.

November 2014

November 4th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Cooperative Forecasting Committee.

November 21st Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

December 2014

December 3rd or 9th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Cooperative Forecasting Committee.

December 19th Local jurisdictional totals are reviewed by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

January 2014

January 16th Final Local jurisdictional totals are approved by the Planning Directors Technical Advisory Committee.

February 2014

Round 8.4 TAZ level forecast are due to COG staff by February 1, 2015.

February 11th COG Board approves Round 8.4 as inputs for TPB's Air Quality Conformity Analysis.

Mid-February 2015

TAZ level forecasts are transmitted to Transportation Planning Staff.

March – September 2015





US Employment--Total Nonfarm, By Place of Work




Employment--Total Non-Agriculture, By Place of Work

US Employment--Total Manufacturing, By Place of Work






US Employment--Professional and Business Services








US Employment--Government, Federal
