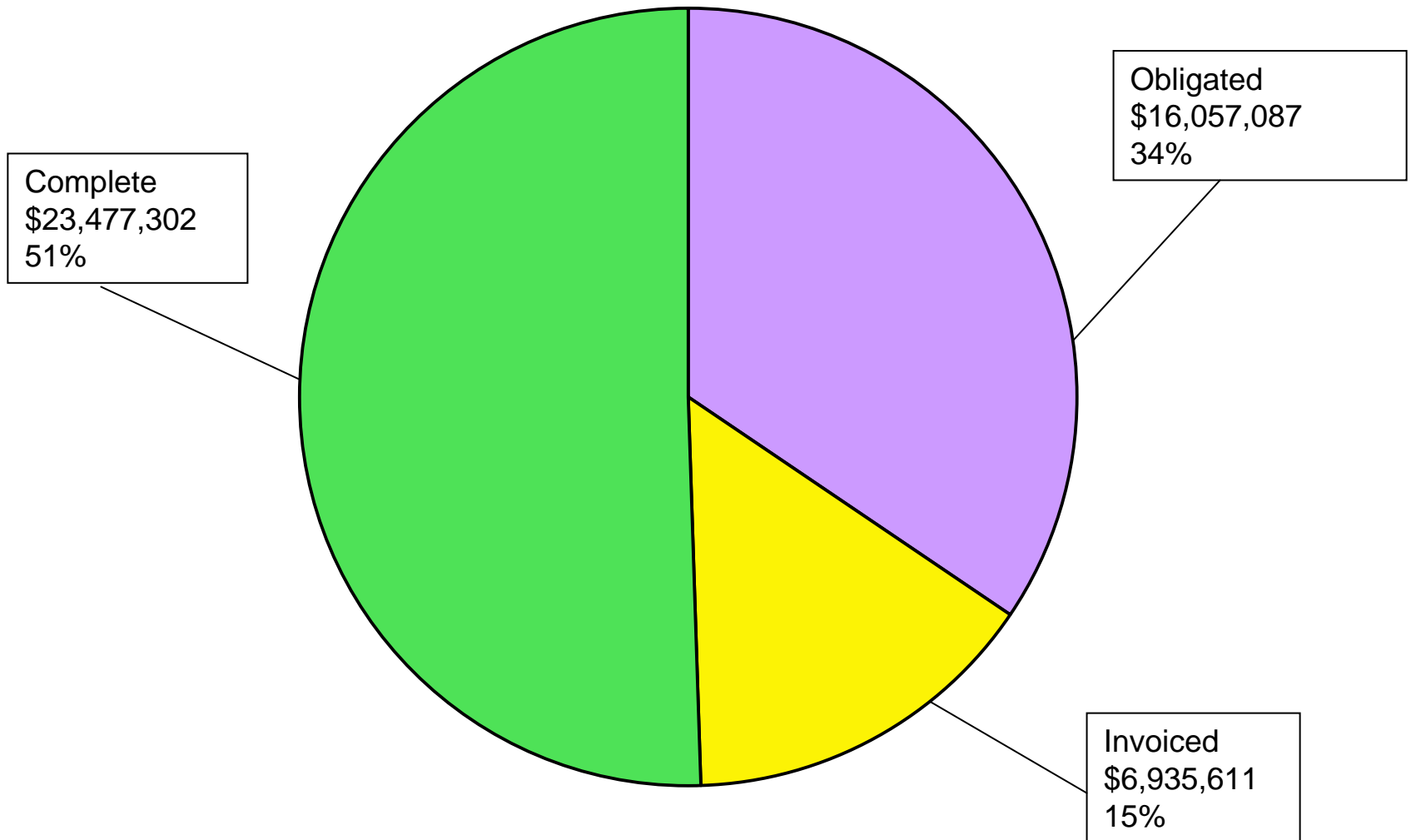

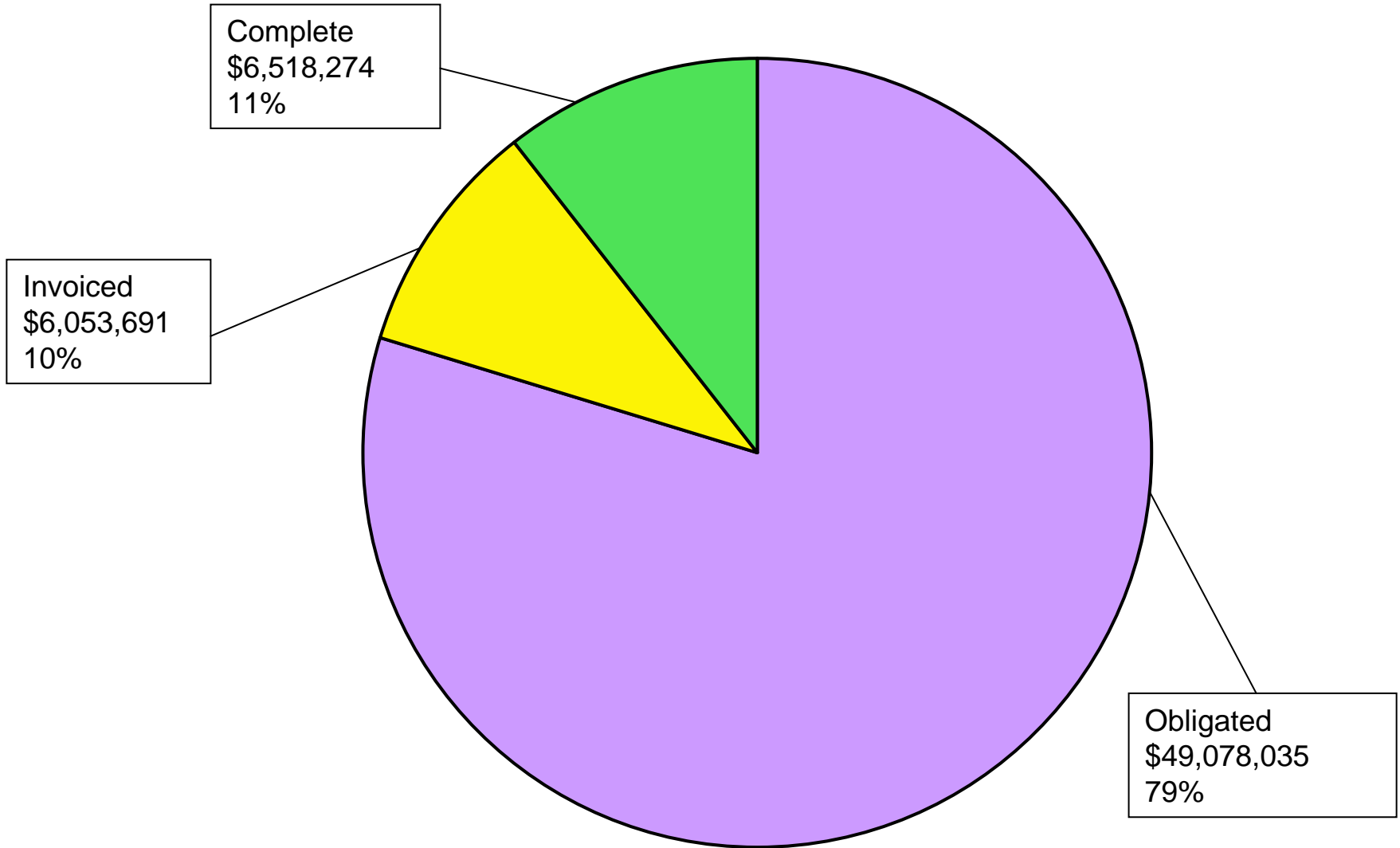
NCR UASI grant overview – 2006 & 2007

- FY 2006 UASI award - \$46.47 Million
 - FY 2006 UASI period of performance expires June 30, 2009
- FY 2007 UASI award - \$61.65 Million
 - FY 2007 UASI period of performance expires June 30, 2010

FY 2006 NCR UASI - \$46,470,000



FY 2007 NCR UASI - \$61,650,000



FY 2008 NCR UASI - \$58,900,500

- \$58.2 Million has been awarded to sub-grantees
- Some projects are being re-scoped and revising project plans based on awarded amount
- FY 2008 UASI period of performance ends August 31, 2011

What's New in 2009

- Risk-based award amounts are announced up-front. Applicants may receive between 90%-110% of that “target amount” depending on the application’s effectiveness score.
 - NCR UASI target amount: \$58,006,500
 - Potential range of awards: \$52.2M - \$63.8M
- \$15.2 Million must be allocated to Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention
- 25% must be allocated to strengthening Preparedness Planning (planning, training, exercises) – \$14.5M
- Applications are due on March 20, 2009
