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The Round 8.1 Cooperative Forecasts . . .

- ... establish new base year (2010) by integrating Census 2010 results and incorporating new employment data (InfoUSA/State ES-202).
- ... opportunity for jurisdictions to incorporate changes in land use such as the Tysons Corner Plan and BRAC such as the Mark Center and the St. Elizabeth's Campus.
- ... "synching" land use with the Financially Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan.
- ... planned to be used in upcoming Air Quality Conformity Analysis through the 2040 forecast period.
