




Grant Spending - FY 2005 and 2006 UASI

FY 2006 UASI \$46.47 Million Awarded








FY 2007 UASI grant


- The Award Letter was received from DHS on September 10.
 - \$61.65 Million in UASI grant funding.
- The period of performance runs from July 1, 2007 June 30, 2010.
 - Sub-grant awards will still be for 2 years.
- Approximately 75 individual sub-grants for FY 2007 UASI. Number will increase (State projects and dividing up some of the larger regional projects).
- The SAA office is collecting and reviewing project plans now, in order to issue sub-grant award letters as soon as possible.
 - Anticipate no difficulty meeting the 80% pass-through requirement.
- The SAA Office's budget authority within D.C. government was approved and loaded earlier this week.



NCR SAA Office - GrantAccess

- GrantAccess stores
 - Project management plans, status reports, deliverable documents
 - Performance schedule
 - Downloaded NCR|GMS vouchers
- With a few button clicks, actual spending from NCR|GMS and performance schedule from GrantAccess can be compared







An on-line system for issuing grant awards, receiving requests for reimbursement, and providing grant financial management.

What it does for:

1) Sub-grantees / Project Managers

- Easier to keep track of project financial status
- Shorter turn-around time for reimbursements
- One place to submit and retrieve information

2) SAA Office / Program Management

- Easier to follow numerous sub-grants over multiple grant years
- Able to track sub-grantee spending much closer to real-time
- Moves the SAA away from being dependent on paper
- Pre-populates standard DHS required reports such as the Biannual Status Review (BISR).


3) Senior Leadership – Oversight

- Better visibility of entire UASI grant or jurisdiction/project specific
- Information is available on-demand. You have direct access to it.






NCR GMS shows financial status at each step of the award / spending / reimbursement cycle. Much more accurate picture than "Spent" vs. "Unspent".
