Recently, the U.S. Census Bureau invited you to participate in the 2010 Census Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) Program by sending you registration forms and other information. Through your government's participation in the LUCA Program, your local knowledge can help ensure that we achieve complete coverage in our enumeration of your jurisdiction. Census data directly affects how more than \$300 billion per year in federal and state funding is allocated to local, state and tribal governments.

You are invited to attend a training regarding the Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) Program for the 2010 Decennial Census. The LUCA program has strict deadlines, technical procedures, different types of participation options, and legal requirements. You received a Computer Based Training (CBT) CD-ROM in your LUCA registration packet that explains how you can participate in LUCA. The CBT covers the same information as the upcoming trainings. However, the classroom training allows you to ask questions and to strategize with your neighboring jurisdictions.

Enclosed, please find a training schedule and a LUCA Training Registration Form. We urge you to send the appropriate representatives from your jurisdiction to attend this training, even if your jurisdiction is undecided about participating in the LUCA Program.
