The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) had its first meeting with its 2019 membership on Wednesday, February 13. At the meeting members met each other, listened to TPB Chair Nohe's plans for 2019 and discussed those plans briefly, and learned about the CAC mission.

DISCUSSION ABOUT THE YEAR AHEAD

Martin Nohe, TPB Chair and Prince William County Supervisor, addressed the committee and shared his vision for the year ahead. He talked about the importance of incentivizing teleworking across the region. He said he would like to help the board translate its visionary goals to fit all jurisdictions and to work together as a single region. He thanked committee members for their service and said he was excited to work with them over the next year.

During a discussion with the chair, CAC members offered their own thoughts for the year ahead. One member asked about regional financing for transportation projects, and suggested congestion pricing. Another encouraged the board to look at international examples for best practices around bicycle and pedestrian safety.

UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM: FY 2020 DRAFT

Lyn Erickson, TPB Plan Coordination and Program Director, provided an overview of the roles and federal requirements of Metropolitan Planning Organizations. She described the TPB planning area membership, and committee structures. She provided a high-level snapshot of the annual budget and an overview of activities that will be conducted by TPB staff in FY 2020.

- John Swanson, TPB Transportation Planner, briefed the committee on past activities and achievements of the CAC in order to give the committee a sense of how it might structure its work this year.
