

CAIR Timeline- Federal

- Promulgate CAIR Rule 2005 **State Implementation Plans Due** 2006 National Phase I Cap for NO_x 2009 National Phase I Cap for SO₂ 2010
- National Phase II Cap for NO_X and SO₂ 2015

Virginia Proposal: Changes to the Model Rule

- Variations to Comply with State Code
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 New Source Set aside
- Voluntary public health set-aside
- Only allowances allocated by the Board are to be used to comply in nonattainment areas

Specific to NO_X Annual Program

- NO_X Annual Trading Budget
 - □ 36,074 tons 2009 through 2014
 - □ 30,062 tons 2015 and thereafter
- Compliance Pool: 5,134 tons
 - Avoid an "undue risk to the reliability of electricity"
 - Distributed to the sources prior to 11/30/09
 - Valid for the 2009 control period only

Specific to NO_X Seasonal Program

- NOx Season Trading Budgets for EGUs
 - □ Current Budget under NOx SIP Call : 21,195 tons/season
 - 15,994 tons 2009 through 2014
 - □ 13,328 tons 2015 and thereafter
- Included Non-EGU NO_X SIP Call units
- Non-EGUs Budget:
 - □ 3,840 tons 2009-thereafter
 - Reduced from the NO_X SIP Call budget of 4104 tons
- Efficient energy/renewable energy set aside
 - □ 36 tons/yr

Specific to SO₂ Annual Program

- The SO2 annual trading budgets for EGUs
 - □ 63,478 tons 2010 through 2014
 - □ 44,435 tons 2015 and thereafter
- EPA has already allocated the allowances under Acid Rain Program
- Allowances valid indefinitely
- Value is reduced over time
