



#### **OVERVIEW**

- Commuter Connections began exploring new tools to supplement existing carpools/vanpools and promote the creation of new pools for the Washington D.C. metropolitan region (2013-2016)
- CarpoolNow a real-time, dynamic, mobile based matching application aimed at the gig generation which also includes an incentive program for drivers available for any trip that touches Howard County, MD (2017)
- Flextime Rewards an incentive program benefit to commuters who are able to adjust their commute during peak hours to avoid congestion along major corridors in the region, during a major incident or significantly higher-than-average traffic volume days (2017)


- Standard TDM registration process
- Standard required information






#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – PROGRAM REGISTRATION

- Familiar program registrationPage
- User selects Flextime Rewards to enroll




#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – PROGRAM REGISTRATION

- Participants delay their trip to/from work during peak times should incidents service/speed rates change
- Participants receive real-time traffic alerts (email, SMS, & push notifications in the event of a change
- Corridors include I-270 spur (IL), I-495 b/w I-95 and MD-193 (OL), I-66 EB @ VA-267, DC-295 SB @Benning Road




#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – PROGRAM REGISTRATION

- Participants identify the eligible corridor they expect to travel
- Participants indicate their usual departure times for work and home
- Participants indicate how flexible they are around their departure times
- Participants indicate what days they wish to receive notifications




#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – PROGRAM CONFIRMATION

- Welcome message that provides a brief overview of the program
- Provides brief instructions and guides user to the Commute Log Calendar




#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – COMMUTE LOG SETUP

- User must setup their
   Commuter Log Profile with the data relative to their commute
- Commute Log Calendar is familiar to users of the system as the interface is the same




#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – CONGESTION NOTIFICATION

- Commuter Connections TDM
   System send a communication
   that there is congestion on the
   calculated route
- Provides suggested alternate departure times to improve trip travel time



#### FLEXTIME REWARDS – COMMUTE FLEX RECORDING

- Participants must record their trip data including their alternate trip (flex) time
- Participants who successfully record their trip data will be eligible to be entered in an incentive drawing that will include prizes and possibly cash



## CARPOOLNOW


- Same user interface that users are familiar with
- Application works the same for users participating in the incentive as for those who are not






### CARPOOLNOW – DRIVER INCENTIVE

 Drivers must access the Driver Incentive Menu by clicking on the menu icon on the top right corner of the application



#### CARPOOLNOW – DRIVER INCENTIVE

- For any trips touching Howard County, MD, Commuter Connections will pay the driver up to \$10.00/trip
- Drivers must agree to the participation guidelines in order to receive the incentive
- Qualifying trips must take place during periods of peak congestion; M-F, 6 am
   9 am and 4:30 pm 7:30 pm
- Trips are validated using GIS capabilities in the driver's mobile device
