

#### **Square Footage of Completed Commercial Construction by Structure Type, 1990 - 2020**






 All major COG counties added commercial space in 2020.


 Office construction was the largest source of new space and was mostly built near Metrorail stations.








## **Share of Construction Square Footage in Activity Centers and High-Capacity Transit Station Areas**






### Vacancy Rate for Office Space, 1993 – 2020






# Change in Office Vacancy Rates Q1 2020 vs Q1 2021






# Change in Retail Vacancy Rates Q1 2020 vs Q1 2021
