TALKING POINTS ABOUT VISUALIZE 2045:

- Visualize 2045 is being developed by the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), the federally designated metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for metropolitan Washington. The TPB is housed at and staffed by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG).
- Explain your connection to the TPB and why you care about regional transportation.
- The outreach activity is highlighting the TPB's Aspirational Initiatives and asks people in the region to tell us how they affect their lives.

The seven initiatives are:

- Bring Jobs and Housing Closer Together
- Expand Bus Rapid Transit Regionwide
- Move More People on Metrorail
- Provide More Telecommuting and Other Options for Commuting
- Expand Express Highway Network
- Improve Walk and Bike Access to Transit
- Complete the National Trail Network
