CLIMATE AND ENERGY LEADERSHIP AWARDS

SAMPLE JUDGES SCORE SHEET

The Climate and Energy Leadership Awards will recognize innovative programs/projects that have reduced greenhouse gas emissions in the National Capital Region.

All applications will be judged on four criteria: **Results, Creativity, Model, and Engagement**. Results will be weighed more heavily and account for 40% of the total score. Creativity, Model and Engagement will each account for 20% of the score.

Judges will provide a 1-5 score for each of the judging criteria: **1 = Poor; 2 = Fair; 3 = Adequate; 4 = Good; and 5 = Excellent**. Judges will use the [Judging Rubric](#) for ranking guidance. Scores will be totaled and weighed by COG staff.
