

WHAT WE DO


- Create community economic development via food system.
- Establish vertically integrated community farms and food hubs.
- Provide collaborative backbone infrastructure for inclusion in new food system.
- Job creation, workforce & entrepreneurship development.



COMMUNITIES AND FARMERS

CHALLENGES, OPPORTUNITIES

- Communities face high unemployment, lack of economic opportunity; lack of access to healthy food choices.
- Challenged to locate farmers markets EoR;
 farmers dependent upon retail sales, long travel.
- Farmers lack connections within cities to connect to potential wholesale markets.
- Both farmers and communities lack infrastructure and relationships to bridge gaps, create opportunity for all.

THE FARM AT KELLY MILLER

- Partnership with District agencies DPR, DDOEE
- 2-acre farm and food hub
- •\$250,000 DC government infrastructure investment
- Located behind Kelly Miller Middle School,
 Lincoln Heights, Clay Terrace, Richardson
 Dwellings
- Partnership with sweetgreen \$25,000 and refrigerated truck.
- Engaged with and invited to foundation funding.
- •\$200k LFPP grant to add capacity, infrastructure



PROPOSED

MALCOLM X COMMUNITY FARM AND FOOD HUB

- One acre farm and food hub, leveraging existing infrastructure for community impact
- Shared commercial kitchen space, business incubator / accelerator
- Refrigerated storage, freezers for aggregation / distribution of healthy food
- Infrastructure to support scaled impact East of the River
