- 6:00 – 6:45** **Discussion of Regional Transportation and Land Use Issues From the Perspective of the District of Columbia's Office of Planning**
Barry Miller of the DC Office of Planning will brief the CAC on regional implications of key planning issues the District is confronting. Mr. Miller will describe the District's concerns with the jobs/housing imbalance as reflected in COG's most recent Cooperative Land Use Forecasts. More broadly, Mr. Miller will discuss the regional implications of the District's current comprehensive plan update, including the plan's policies regarding employment and housing growth.

At their May meetings, both the TPB and COG directed staff to conduct an analysis of transportation and land use implications of the recent BRAC proposal. Stewart Schwartz of the Coalition for Smarter Growth and Bob Chase of the Northern Virginia Transportation Alliance will offer their perspectives on the proposal.
