Background

- In May of 2023, the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) adopted its FY24 work program including an objective to include a racial equity lens in work activities. The committee also included a goal of developing a new document to address environmental justice in air quality planning.
- As part of COG's work:
 - ACPAC is to update its 2017 EJ Toolkit.
 - The Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG) climate plan program for the MSA requires significant new community engagement, emphasizing J40 and LIDAC. Consultant proposals currently under review include EJ/Equity/Community Engagement.



Proposed Approach

- What is MWAQC Planning to Do?
- Recommend a multi-pronged approach
 - 1. Partner with COG EJ Toolkit
 - 2. Partner with COG CPRG grant program
 - 3. NEW Resource Guide document, joint exercise of COG and MWAQC
- This approach would be consistent with:
 - MWAQC Resolution from May
 - COG's Region United Framework
 - Requirements for the CPRG Plan



Resource Guide Document

- What will resource guide be about?
 - Potential outline for EJ resource
 - Look for best practices in different sectors
 - How identify and quantify inequities in all sectors that are attributable to environmental policies, programs, and projects
 - Drivers causing in equities
 - Opportunities to address inequities
 - How factor them into policies, programs, and policies to help address criteria or GHGs or other environmental issue.



Immediate Actions/Next Steps

- Survey and hold focus group discussions with COG member staff and experts to identify resource and assistance needs
- Plan and hold community engagement
- Hire consultant to assist:
 - Update EJ Toolkit
 - Develop EJ Resource Guide Document
 - Member, expert and community engagement with emphasis on low-income disadvantaged communities.

 - Develop Regional EJ Resource Guide
