sed Updates to the Round 7.0 Cooperative Forecasts

Development Policy Committee approved the final Round 30. Since that time, several jurisdictions have expressed an interest in updating their forecasts to reflect the U.S. Department of Defense BRAC decisions and other local land use changes. During their February 6 meeting, the Cooperative Forecasting Subcommittee reviewed the draft updates to the Round 7.0 Cooperative Forecasts and recommended that approval of the projections be delayed till 2007 due to the need for additional information on BRAC impacts, as well as uncertainty concerning assumptions for additional population and household growth.

During their February 8 meeting, COG Board of Directors Chair Fisette briefed the Board on a proposed series of tasks to update the 3-year Policy Focus on Growth. Included in the proposal are several projects and tasks that would be reviewed by the Planning Directors and the Metropolitan Development Policy Committee. Staff will brief the Committee on this presentation and seek recommendations on next steps.

Update on Work on Regional Activity Center and Cluster Analysis of Round 7 **Gregory Goodwin** 10:55 a.m. – 11:15 a.m. **Charles Grier COG Staff**

In approving the final Regional Activity Centers in 2002, the COG Board and TPB directed that the map(s) be revised following the completion of the next major "Round" of Cooperative Forecasts. During the October 14 meeting, PDTAC members directed COG staff to undertake a preliminary analysis of the Round 7.0 Forecasts. COG staff also briefed the Metropolitan Development Policy Committee (MDPC), National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) and TPB Technical Committee during their respective meetings in November. Staff will update the Committee on recommendations from those groups, present additional work undertaken by COG staff to analyze the Centers and Clusters, and seek guidance from Committee members on a proposed schedule for updating the Activity Centers.
