

Adaptation Services for Local Governments

ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability, USA (ICLEI) and Adaptation Services Group (ASG) provide climate adaptation advisory services to local governments.

Our work with communities in identifying the specific likelihood of extreme and chronic weather events uses Temperate, a climate-science driven model, to create a threat-assessment for participating communities for their future use.

Many cities lack identification of the climate hazards and vulnerabilities specific to their community and the technical support to interpret and apply the data. Temperate reports will be prepared by ASG experts and delivered to policy makers, city staff, and stakeholders in a manner that is understandable and actionable.

ASG will use Temperate in the following ways:

- Threat Identification identify changing climate conditions that will have an impact on the community.
- Impact Potential match climate threats with community systems. ASG will provide a
 report of the implications to the local government, including impacts on public health,
 water management, land use, and other areas, with a focus on equity considerations across
 all types of impacts.
- Vulnerability Assessment –create a vulnerability assessment that utilizes interdepartmental collaboration and community stakeholder engagement.
- Suggested Actions provide suggested starting points for strategy development, based on a compilation of more than forty cities' adaptation plans and ASG direct experience.

For communities participating in the voluntary Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy, Temperate uses the same hazards and community systems that the Global Covenant asks their signatories to assess.
