Update on WMATA's ConnectGreaterWashington Regional Transit System Plan and Request for Local Data on Construction

ConnectGreaterWashington (CGW) is WMATA's regional transit system plan for 2040. It builds on the projects in the CLRP as well as the projects that help to maximize the existing Metrorail and Metrobus system outlined in Momentum (e.g. those projects in Metro 2025). Allison Davis of WMATA will update the committee on work to date on this project. In addition, Michael Eichler of WMATA will brief the Committee on a proposed new WMATA GIS project request for local government permitting data. The purpose of the project is to build an updatable Graphical Information System (GIS)-based tool summarizing known planned, proposed, and pipeline real estate development projects located within the WMATA Compact jurisdictions. This tool will be used to inform Metro's understanding of potential Metrorail system pressures that may evolve in a near-term (1-10 years) planning horizon.
