Opportunity #1 – Electric Vehicles

1. Support Acceleration of Electric Vehicle (EV) Deployment
 - a) Local Government Lead by Example - Convert Fleets
 - b) EV Infrastructure Planning
 - i. Identify Locations for Electric Vehicle Chargers
 - ii. Streamline Zoning and Permitting



Opportunity #2 – Renewable Energy

2. Commit to 100
 - a) Local Government Lead by Example – Procure 100% Renewable Electricity
 - b) Deploy Solar on Government Buildings
 - c) Incentivize and Support Residents and Businesses to Install Solar



Opportunity #3 – Building Efficiency

3. Enhance Building Energy Performance
 - a) Local Government Lead by Example – Track Energy Consumption for All Government Buildings, including Schools
 - b) Consider Building Energy Performance Standards
 - c) Support Adoption of Most Recent Building Codes

Federal Aid - Clean Fuel Vehicle Deployment

Select new DOT programs of the 2021 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

- Carbon Reduction Program – 5 year, \$6.4B in formula funds; States to develop carbon reduction strategy, in consultation with MPOs
- PROTECT Program – 5 year, \$7.3B in formula funds for resiliency planning and improvements including evacuation routes
- PROTECT Discretionary Grants – 5 year, \$1.4B; Local governments and MPOs eligible
- EV Charging & Fueling Infrastructure – 5 year, \$2.5B in discretionary grant to deploy EV charging and other clean fuel infrastructure along designated AF corridors; Local governments and MPOs eligible



Federal Aid - Clean Fuel Vehicle Deployment

- EV Vehicle Program – 5 year, \$5B in formula funds to deploy interconnected network of EV charging infrastructure
- Congestion Relief – 5 year, \$250M discretionary grant for innovative, integrated multi-modal solutions (e.g., pricing, mobility solutions)
