### **MWAQC Budget Process**

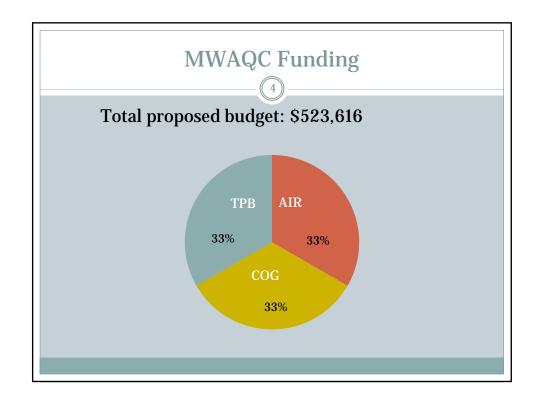


- FY 2016 MWAQC Budget Proposed, February 19
  - Proposed budget is the same as FY 2015
  - Comments received and revised Work Plan sent to Budget Committee in March and TAC in April and May
- TPB adopted Transportation Unified Plan and Work Program in March
  - × Used 2015 MWAQC contribution amount
  - × May need to revise once DOT allocation announced

## FY 2016 Program Objectives



- Plan for ozone control measures to meet 2008 federal ozone standard (75 ppb) and future standard
  - o Plan for "bump up." Develop SIP for 2008 ozone standard
  - o Plan for designation of a revised ozone standard
  - o Identify measures/early actions to meet current and future standards
  - Track attainment modeling, state/local measures
  - Multi-pollutant control strategies (cost-effectiveness and co-benefits that reduce air pollutants)
- Review transportation conformity analyses for ozone, fine particles, carbon monoxide
  - MOVES2014 mobile inventories
- Public participation, meeting support, and program administration
