 from Woodbridge to
 Tysons via the Express
 Lanes
- » Fairfax County Connector launched its express bus service to Tysons from Burke with additional routes from Lorton and Springfield added in March 2013

- » 59% of Beltway drivers see the benefit of the Express Lanes to the region
- » Top reasons travelers had used the Express Lanes:
 - 68% "needed" to reach a destination on time*
 - 46% used due to congestion on the regular Beltway lanes
 - 30% interested in a reliable trip
 - 30 % wanted a less stressful trip

95 Express Lanes



- » Nearly \$1 billion publicprivate partnership
- Spans 29 miles from near
 Edsall Road in Fairfax
 County to Garrisonville
 Road in Stafford County
- » Project extends road nine miles south from current ending point at Dumfries
- » Two lanes wide from Garrisonville Road to Prince William Parkway; three lanes from Parkway to Edsall Road



95 Express Lanes



- » Reversible with similar timing as today's HOV system
- » Dynamic system with variable tolls to manage traffic
- » HOV-3+, transit and motorcycles ride toll-free with E-ZPass Flex
- » E-ZPass required for all users



Key Project Benefits



- » Expand system from two to three lanes for 14 miles between Prince William Parkway and Edsall Road
- » Nine-mile extension from Dumfries to Garrisonville Road; alleviate bottleneck where HOV ends today
- » Regional HOV/bus network with seamless connection to 495 Express Lanes
- » Improve system performance through enhanced enforcement and incident response
- » New access points to better connect I-95 to Virginiabased destinations and military sites
- » Carpool advantage 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- » HOV only beyond Edsall Road

Safety



- 24-hour safety monitoring from Express Lanes Operations Center
- » Real-time traffic information and Express Assist
- » Express Assist incident response working with law enforcement, VDOT and emergency services
- » Vehicle detection technology to assist with reversal of traffic flow
- » Gate operations







- » Requiring E-ZPass is effective strategy to keep violators out
- » To ride toll-free,HOV-3+ need E-ZPass Flex
- » Information about E-ZPass Flex is especially important for users traveling HOV lanes today

Clean Fuel Plates	Don't need to meet occupancy requirement and can use lanes during restricted period	Must be HOV-3 for free travel; E-ZPass required
Truckers	3+ axle OK; No E-ZPass required	3+ axles are prohibited; E- ZPass required
Out-of-towners	I-95 is popular traveler corridor but many likely unfamiliar with Express Lanes	E-ZPass required; Express Lanes rules in effect 24/7
Law Enforcement / First Responder	Utilize for commuting purposes	Toll-free in pursuit of duties

User Group	Today's System	Requirements & Access
Single and dual occupant vehicles	Cannot use during restricted hours, but violators are persistent; Shoulder users time travel to take advantage of open HOV lanes	Need E-ZPass or E-ZPass Flex and can use 95 Express Lanes at any time
Motorcycles	No E-ZPass required	No E-ZPass required
Delivery/Commercial	3+ axle OK; No E-ZPass required	3+ axles are prohibited; E- ZPass required
Taxis/Rental Companies/Limos	No E-ZPass required; familiar with rules of HOV system	E-ZPass required
