

# MEETING NOTES 2006 BIKE TO WORK DAY STEERING COMMITTEE

#### 1. Introductions

## 2. Approval of May 10, 2006 meeting minutes

The minutes from the May 10, 2006 BTWD Steering Committee were approved as written.

## 3. Change of Chairperson

Outgoing chairperson Mirza Donegan from North Bethesda Transportation Solutions was thanked and presented with a plaque for her service as the BTWD Chair for 2006. Mimi Murray from Fairfax County was introduced and welcomed as the new incoming chairperson for the 2007 event.

#### 4. BTWD Slideshow 2006

Douglas Franklin played a compellation slideshow of pictures taken at the various 2006 BTWD events, sent in by the pit stops. Pictures showcased the colorful celebrations and fun shared by event organizers, bicyclists, elected officials and volunteers.

#### 5. 2006 Pit Stop Recap

Pit stop managers discussed highlights and shared anecdotes of happening from their 2006 pit stop events. Great weather, generous sponsors and record participation was the common theme.

# 6. BTWD Employer Challenge

Douglas Franklin discussed the Employer Challenge awards given to companies with the greatest participation in the BTWD event. The data used to determine the employer participation was collected from the online registration form, however not all individuals identify their employer. The top two or three companies within each employer size break were sent a plaque. In addition to the plaques, each year Commuter Connections awards a luncheon to the company with greatest overall participation in BTWD. National Institutes of Health was the clear winner at 184 participants. On June 27, 2006 Eric Gilliland and Nick Ramfos presented the plaque at NIH's Bethesda headquarters to NIH staff and bike club

Other top employers who participated included, EPA, AOL, WorldBank and Orbital.
