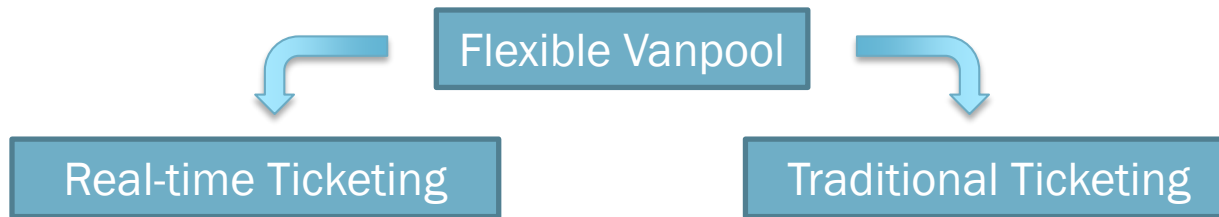

Concept & Context

- Project goal: Introduce technology that aids in finding vanpool riders who may be interested in a flexible arrangement, perhaps riding infrequently or one-time riders
- Flexible Vanpool Workgroup created February 2021
 - Identified critical components for developing flexible vanpool technology
- COG worked through several iterations of work specs in collaboration with software development team
 - Based on workgroup feedback

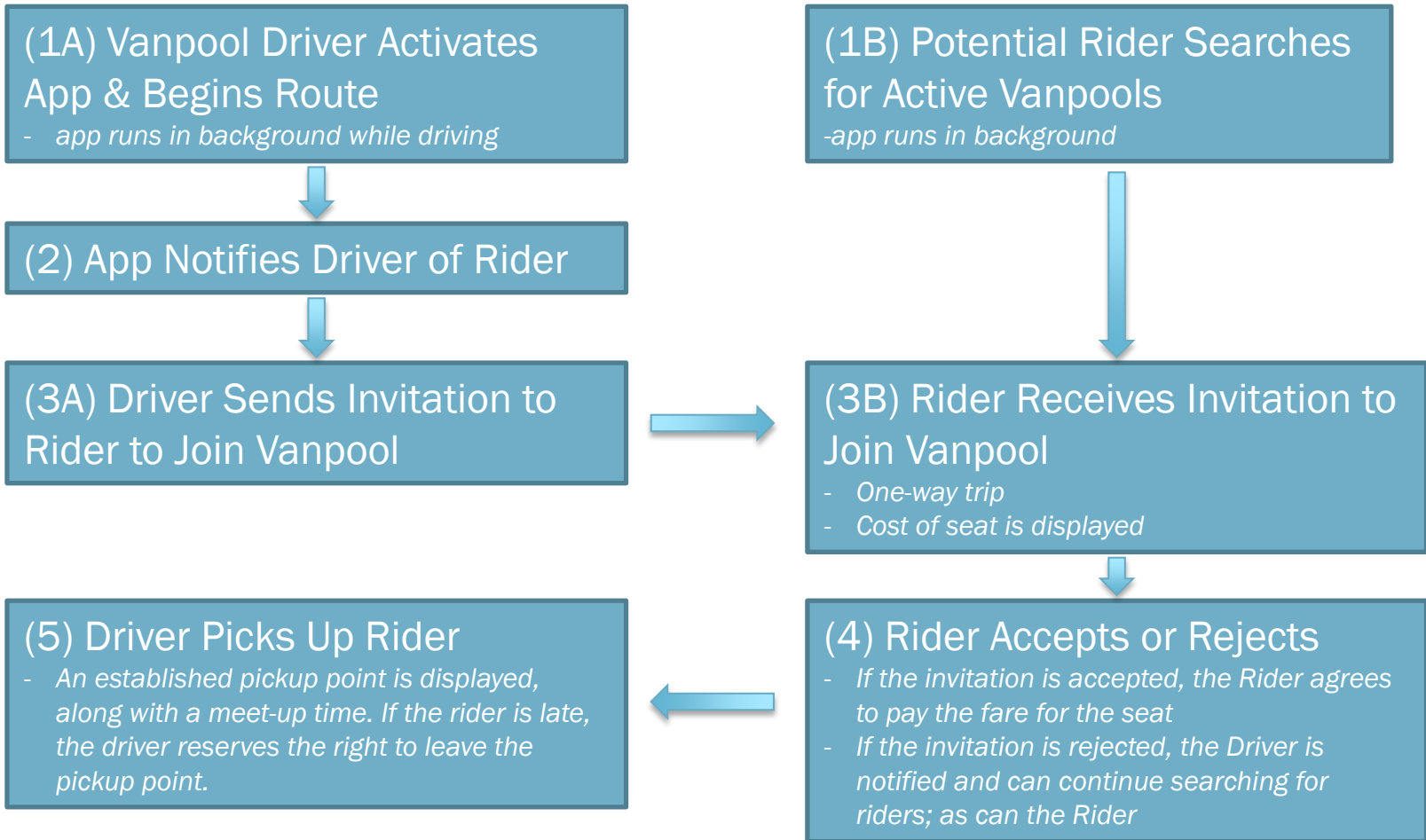
Flexible Vanpool



Real-time Ticketing

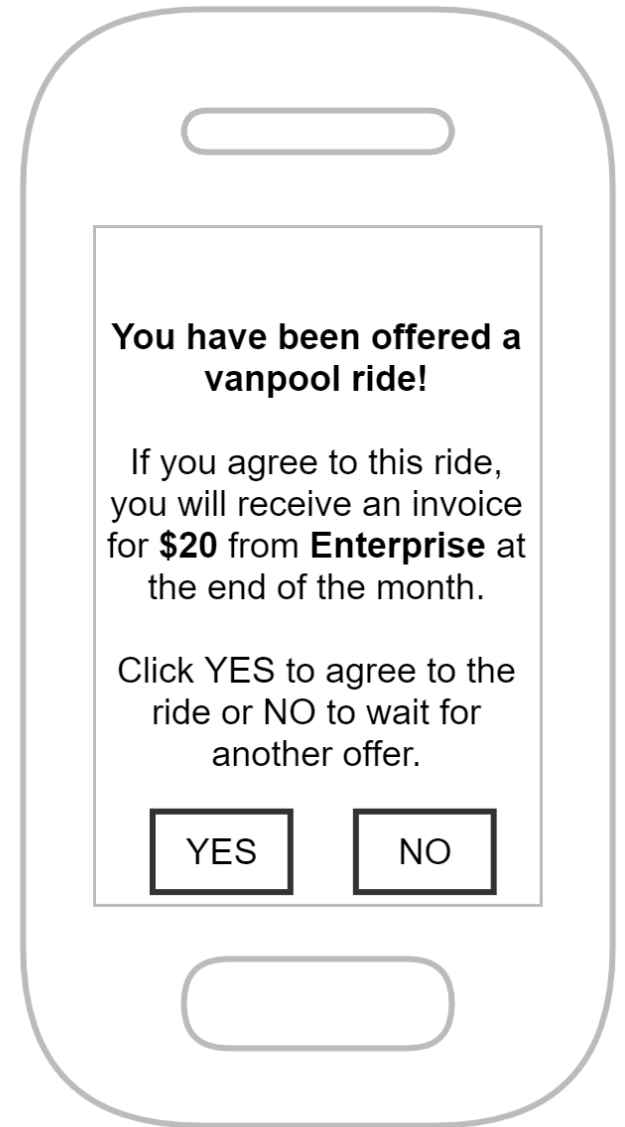
- Nested within CarpoolNow
 - Already compatible for real-time trip monitoring
 - Vanpool enhancements include:
 - New ability to register vanpools / link with TDM System
 - “Start Vanpool” button to be added. Only available to registered vanpool drivers / coordinators
 - Once activated, drivers can offer seats to nearby riders who are currently searching in the mobile app
 - Cost per seat – programmable by the driver
 - Riders can accept or reject offers from vanpool drivers
 - Payment facilitated externally of mobile application

Real-time Ticketing



Payment

- Upon receiving an invitation to join a vanpool, the rider will receive a confirmation screen similar to the image on the right
 - An external solution, such as PayPal, could be utilized instead of a monthly invoice



Traditional Ticketing

- Enhancement within the traditional TDM System
- New generic “Vanpool Operator” role will permit operators to program vanpool routes into the database, which will appear on ridematch searches
 - Will include customizable stops, seat availability, and fare
 - A single operator can create and manage multiple routes
- Potential riders can request to “book a seat” on the van and specify which date, stop, and route (i.e., inbound/outbound)
 - Drivers/coordinators are notified 24hrs+ in advance
 - Payment facilitated externally of TDM System
- CarpoolNow cross functionality: List vanpool route with transit routes upon “10-minute prompt” display

Next Steps

- Development scheduled for Fall 2021
 - Committee members will be asked to test
- Coincide with traditional vanpool enhancements
