Bikes counted using induction loop technology


Pedestrians counted using sensor

Statistics

May-August 2024 Monthly Statistics

- 2,855 combined bike/ped monthly average
 - 1,623/month bike average
 - 1,232/month ped average

Highest activity: VA Center Blvd (near Vienna Metro)

- 4,088 combined bikes/peds in June 2024
- Consistently highest numbers month to month


