▶ **Brief History of TCCSMD:**



- ▶ Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland (TCCSMD) was formed on December 6, 1964, as a cooperative planning and development agency to foster the social and economic development of the Southern Maryland Region. In 1965, the Governor of Maryland recognized the TCCSMD as the regional planning and development organization for the Region comprising of Calvert, Charles and St. Mary's Counties. The TCCSMD's statute was established by Act of the Maryland General Assembly in 1966 and there are 5 Tri-County Councils in the state.
- ▶ The Council brings together local, State and federal resources to address issues in economic development; environmental protection; and regional resource management, which includes transportation, workforce, utilities, urban growth and development.
- ▶ TCCSM's transportation programs are fund by **Metropolitan Washington Council of Government's (COG) Commuter Connections program and the Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Maryland Transit Administration (MTA).**

### New commuting app should help people save time, money

Commuter Connections and the Maryland Transportation Institute at the University of Maryland launched this week Incentivize, a new mobile app that shows commuters in the Washington, D.C., region to save time, money and fuel while exploring rewards for planning trips, according to a Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments press release.

The Incentivize app recommends the best travel route, departure time and route based on real-time traffic predictions and user personal travel preferences to help commuters avoid both day-to-day congestion and traffic jams caused by accidents, work zones, special events and adverse weather conditions, according to the press release.

With the app, commuters can earn rewards points every time they plan trips to and from work, avoid traffic or use alternative routes to decongest commutes, such as carpooling, walking, bicycling, or taking transit. Commuters who use the app during rush hours can earn rewards points for each hour from Commuter Connections. The app provides users a fun and gamified environment, where they can accomplish consistent weekly goals, win challenges, and invite friends to participate.

"The app and its users will help reduce congestion, energy use, and reduce emissions in the region," said Martin Noble, chairman of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board.

The U.S. Department of Energy's Advanced Research Projects Agency funded the Incentivize project with a \$4.5 million grant. The National Science Foundation and the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Highway Administration also provided funding for early stages of Incentivize's technical development. Commuters can download the app today in both the Apple App Store and Google Play.

## New Subsidy to Encourage Vanpooling in the Tri-County Area

Hughesville, MD (March 10, 2022) – As the region reopens and businesses welcome employees back into the office, commuters can take advantage of a new incentive to further help reduce the expenses of an already cost-effective form of public transportation. In partnership with [Commute with Enterprise](http://CommuteWithEnterprise.com), the Tri-County Council is helping to increase the use of a shared mobility option: vanpooling.

The Tri-County Council created the pilot program, providing a \$300 subsidy per van per month to commuters living or working in the Tri-County area including St. Marys, Charles and Calvert Counties. The subsidy can also be combined with other regional subsidy programs if the vanpool group is eligible for both. Each vanpool program is customized to the specific needs of its four or more vanpoolers. The remaining cost is split among participants, with each vanpool rider paying a set fee per month.

John Hartline, Executive Director, said, "I am proud the Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland has started this new van pool program. We are getting people back to work and saving fuel at the same time!" The program is being funded through the Rural Maryland Council.

Participants can choose a qualifying vanpool vehicle from Enterprise's selection of makes and models that includes crossovers, SUVs, minivans and large passenger vans.

Commuter with Enterprise also provides 24-hour roadside assistance, liability insurance and maintenance. And as part of Enterprise's Complete Clean Pledge, Commuter with Enterprise provides best practices for cleaning and Complete Clean Starter Kits for new or returning commuters.
