Chesapeake Bay Program/EPA

EPA TMDLs:

- Establish by December 31, 2010
- Full implementation of <u>controls</u> by 2025 (with 2017 mid-point)

Various Federal Documents Guide State/DC Efforts:

- President's Executive Order
- 202/203 Reports
- EPA Accountability Framework
- EPA Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) and Two-Year Milestone (2YM) Expectations letter
- EPA Consequences letter
- New 'Evaluation Guidelines' for Each of 5 Groups:
 - Pending (March 24, 2010)
 - Wastewater, Stormwater, Agriculture, <u>Tracking & Reporting</u>, and <u>Offsets & New Growth</u>

TMDL Load Allocations

- "Preliminary Basin-wide Target Loads"
 - 200 M lb TN (vs. 175)
 - 15 M lb TP (vs. 12)
 - Deemed sufficient to start WIP planning process
 - Apparently close to original Tributary Strategy level loads
 - Good news but were those actually realistic/achievable?
- Watershed Implementation Plans
 - More Q's than A's COG working to address these
 - State public process to start Nov. 2009

Federal Actions: "Consequences"

- Phase 1 Submitted by:
 - Prelim June 1, 2010
 - Draft August 1, 2010
 - Final November 1, 2010
- Initially project through 2017
- Phase II and III will provide more details in later years
- County Level Allocations in 2012
- Growth Allocation States/DC to identify (if/how)

- WIP Preparation
- TYM Preparation
- TYM Implementation
- NPDES Permits (wastewater & stormwater)
- NPS Mechanism ('reasonable assurance')
- Evaluation Guidelines [Pending]
 - •Wastewater, Stormwater, Agriculture, Tracking & Reporting, and Offsets & New Growth

- 2011 TYMs adopted in 2009 (Statewide)
- Issued every 2 years
- Linked to accountability/consequences
- Future: 2013, 2015, etc. more local

Potential Options:

- 3. Require Net Offsets
- 4. Fine Scale WLAs & Las
- 5. Additional Point Source load reductions
- 6. Enforcement & Compliance

- 3. Require Net Offsets [Accounting for Growth given load caps? By sector]
- 4. Fine Scale Cap Load Allocations (WLAs & LAs) [Retain any county level flexibility?]
- 5. Additional <u>Point Source</u> Load Reductions [Includes Wastewater and Stormwater]
- 6. Enforcement & Compliance [States transference to local level? How applied to sectors/basins/localities?]
- 7. Redirect Grant Funds [? Not sure]
- 8. Implement Local Nutrient Water Quality Std. [? Not sure]
