1. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR VIRGINIA TAP PROJECTS

Under the federal Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TAP), the TPB since 2012 has been responsible for selecting projects using sub-allocated funding for Suburban Maryland, Northern Virginia, and the District of Columbia. The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has identified unobligated funding from a project that that had previously been approved by the TPB and has requested that some of those funds be transferred to another project, also previously approved by the TPB, to cover an increase in cost for advertisement. The Steering Committee will be asked to approve VDOT's requested transfer of funds.

2. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF TRANSMISSION OF TPB COMMENTS ON THE EPA'S 1986 POLICY FOR AFTER-MARKET CATALYTIC CONVERTERS

In a December 14, 2020 Federal Register notice (EPA Tampering Policy: The EPA Enforcement Policy on Vehicle and Engine Tampering and Aftermarket Defeat Devices under the Clean Air Act), the EPA is seeking comment on an existing policy from 1986 concerning after-market catalytic converters. A joint letter from the TPB and the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) has been drafted for review and approval. Because the February 12 comment period deadline is before the TPB meeting, the Steering Committee will be asked to approve this letter.
