At its meeting of July 8, 2005, the TPB Steering Committee approved the following resolutions:

- TPB SR1-2006: Resolution on an Amendment to the FY2005-2010
 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that is exempt from the
 Air Quality Conformity Requirement to modify the funding for seven
 highway projects and two park-and ride lot improvements, and to
 fund a transportation management study as requested by the Virginia
 Department of Transportation (VDOT).
- TPB SR2-2006: Resolution requesting the Virginia Department of Transportation to allocate the FHWA Metropolitan Planning Organization Planning funds attributable to the portion of the Stafford County that is part of the Washington DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area to the Fredericksburg area Metropolitan Planning Organization.

RESOLUTION ON AN AMENDMENT TO
THE FY 2005-2010 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

MANAGEMENT STUDY AS REQUESTED BY THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION (VDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2004 the TPB adopted the 2004 Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (CLRP) and the FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of June 30, 2005, on behalf of Prince William County, the City of Falls Church, and Fairfax County, VDOT has requested an amendment to the FY 2005-2010 TIP to modify the funding for the following seven highway projects: US 1 within Prince William County, US 50 within Arlington County, VA 28 within the City of Manassas, VA 636, VA 638 and VA 7100 within Fairfax County, and VA 734 within Loudoun County; to remove funding from the construction of a parking garage at the Reston East Park-and-Ride Lot and transfer it to a proposed expansion of the Herndon-Monroe Park-and-Ride Lot in Fairfax County; and to fund a Transportation Management Study for the City of Falls Church as described in the attached materials; and

WHEREAS, these projects are either included in the current conformity analysis or are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations "40 CFR Parts 51 and 93 Transportation Conformity Rule Amendments: Flexibility and Streamlining; Final Rule," issued in the August 15, 1997 *Federal Register*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2005-2010 TIP to modify the funding for the following seven highway projects: US 1 within Prince William County, US 50 within Arlington County, VA 28 within the City of Manassas, VA 636, VA 638 and VA

7100 within Fairfax County, and VA 734 within Loudoun County; to remove funding from the construction of a parking garage at the Reston East Park-and-Ride Lot and transfer it to a proposed expansion of the Herndon-Monroe Park-and-Ride Lot in Fairfax County; and to fund a Transportation Management Study for the City of Falls Church, as described in the attached materials.

Dear Chairman Mendelson:

On behalf of Prince William County (copy attached), the City of Falls Church (copy attached), Fairfax County (copy attached), and itself, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests an amendment (attached) to the FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Table 1 (also attached) provides additional details on the individual projects included in the TIP amendment, including the reason(s) each project is included in this request, conformity status, and funding implications.

This TIP amendment proposes the following:

- addition of a right-of-way (R/W) phase in FY 2005 and a \$266 K increase in the construction (CN) phase for a US 1 / VA 619 project to improve the access to the future USMC Heritage Center in Quantico. Additionally, the CN phase will move from FY 2005 to FY 2006;
- addition of a \$4,000 K R/W phase in FY 2005 and a \$382 K increase in the CN phase in FY-06 for the US 50 / Courthouse Road Interchange reconstruction project in Arlington County;
- addition of a Transportation Management Study project in the City of Falls Church funded by FY-06 RSTP funds:

- addition of a \$12,406 K R/W phase in FY 2005 and a \$4,217 K increase in the CN phase for the VA 28 Overpass & Interchange (Phase II) project in the City of Manassas. Additionally, the CN phase will move from FY 2007 to FY 2009;
- add additional funding for the preliminary engineering (PE) phase, reduce funding for the R/W phase, and increase funding for the CN phase for an HES safety project on VA 636 (Hooes Road) in Fairfax County;
- increase the R/W phase estimate for a VA 638 (Rolling Road) widening project in Fairfax County and spread the funding over several years;
- add additional funding for the PE phase for the Fairfax County Parkway / Fair Lakes Parkway Interchange project in Fairfax County;
- addition of the project to rehabilitate the Hibbs Bridge on VA 734 (Snickersville Turnpike) over Beaverdam Creek – additional funding for the PE phase, and add the R/W and CN phases to the TIP; and
- remove funding from the proposed construction of a parking garage at the Reston East Parkand-Ride Lot in Fairfax County and transfer it to a proposed expansion of the Herndon-Monroe Park-and-Ride Lot. (The Reston East project will be constructed during Phase I of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.)

The changes to the projects described in the preceding list will not adversely affect the air quality conformity analyses performed for the FY-05 TIP. For further elaboration, please refer to Table 1.

VDOT requests that these amendments be approved by the TPB Steering Committee at its meeting on July 8, 2005.


Since this project is already included in the TIP and the changes are only funding shifts, we believe they are exempt and no environmental assessment is needed.



RESOLUTION REQUESTING

THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALLOCATE THE FHWA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION PLANNING FUNDS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE PORTION OF THE STAFFORD COUNTY THAT IS PART OF THE WASHINGTON DC-VIRGINIA-MARYLAND URBANIZED AREA TO THE FREDERICKSBURG AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) is the officially designated metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region; and

WHEREAS, the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) is the officially designated MPO for the Fredericksburg Area which includes the City of Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania and Stafford Counties; and

WHEREAS, the US Census Bureau's designation of the urbanized boundary for the Washington, DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area, based on the 2000 Census, places a portion of Stafford County in the Washington, DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2004, the TPB chairman executed an agreement with FAMPO which identified the TPB and FAMPO transportation planning responsibilities for that portion of Stafford County that is part of the Washington, DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area as authorized by Resolution R1-2005 adopted by the TPB on July 21, 2004; and

WHEREAS, under the agreement between the TPB and FAMPO all requirements for planning activities for the Stafford County portion of the Metropolitan Washington Urbanized Area will be conducted by FAMPO; and

WHEREAS, VDOT allocates the FHWA planning funds for metropolitan planning organizations (MPO) to the TPB based upon the Washington, DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area population which includes the urbanized area of northern Stafford County; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the FHWA planning funds made available for the MPO planning requirements in northern Stafford County be received by the organization responsible for such activities as stipulated by the November 17, 2004 agreement between the TPB and FAMPO;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board approves requesting that the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) attribute the portion of the Washington, DC-Virginia-Maryland urbanized area population in northern Stafford County to the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization for the allocation of the FHWA planning funds for metropolitan planning organizations beginning in FY 2006.
