Ride On OVERVIEW

RIDE ON BUS SERVI

Current State

- Ridership down 7% YTD
- Over capacity on MD 355 Corridor (Routes 46 & 55)
- Increasing traffic congestion

Future State

- 3 Tiers of Bus Service
 - Ride On
 - ▶ Ride On extRa (an extension of Ride On brand)
 - BRT (separate and distinct brand)
 - Reduces congestion on major arteries









Ride On extRa - Service

- Limited Stop service: operates between Lakeforest Transit Center and Medical Center Metro Station.
- Due to limited stops-the Ride On extRa will operate 30-40% quicker than local buses.
- Transit Signal Priority (TSP) will be installed at 30 intersections to help ensure the Ride On extRa service reliability.
- 14 dedicated and specially branded buses will be utilized to provide
 10 minute headways during the peak periods (530a-930a/330p-730p).
- Buses will include WiFi and USB charging outlets.
- ▶ 12 bus stops in each direction will be provided with new amenities including Real Time Information Monitors.
- Connections will be made to multiple MetroRail Red Line Stations, the MARC Brunswick Line, MTA Commuter buses, 42 Ride On routes and 15 MetroBus routes while serving high residential and commercial points in the corridor.
- ► The Ride On extRa will begin operation October 2, 2017.
