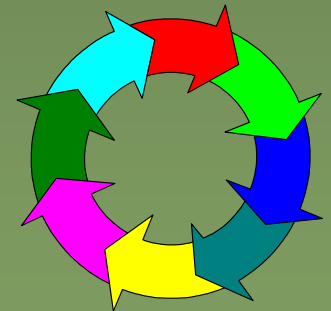
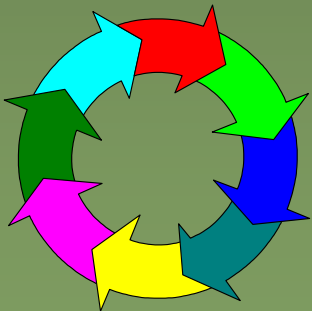

EMAD

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, visitors may operate manual or electric wheelchairs in Anne Arundel County Recreation and Parks facilities.

Wheelchair” means a mobility aid belonging to any class of three or four wheeled devices, usable indoors, 30 inches in width 48 inches in length measured two inches above the ground and designed for and used by a mobility impaired individual, whether operated manually or powered.
