WHEREAS, the report presents a comparative analysis of the statistics reported by the respective jurisdictions through Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) or the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS), providing a broad overview of the nature of crime in the region; and

WHEREAS, such information has proven useful in providing a summary of crime trends to law enforcement and policy officials and establishing local and regional crime-fighting priorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:
