PUBLIC MEETING PURPOSE

To learn about the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) proposed new three year (FY 2016-2018) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for projects it administers and those performed by sub recipients and receive comment from interested parties in compliance with federal regulations, 49 CFR Part 26.

Covers COG's federal transportation projects both as a direct recipient and as a sub-recipient.

PROCESS

INDUSTRY STANDARD METHODOLOGY UTILIZED:

DATA COLLECTION

- Compiled a list of all 15 planned transportation projects worth \$20 million over 3 fiscal years
- Compiled a bidders list from previously awarded projects

DATA ANALYSIS

- Matched planned projects with appropriate North American Industry Classification (NAICS) Codes
- Researched Census Bureau information and State Unified Certification Program (UCP) DBE Directories to determine availability of DBE's in COG's market area

PROCESS

GOAL DEVELOPMENT

- Determining availability of Ready, Willing and Able DBE's
- Adjustment of Base Figure Using Established Formulas
- Determining the Race/Gender-Neutral and Race/Gender-Conscious Split

NARRATIVE JUSTIFICATION

- To be submitted to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA)
- Once approved by FTA, will be posted on COG's website
