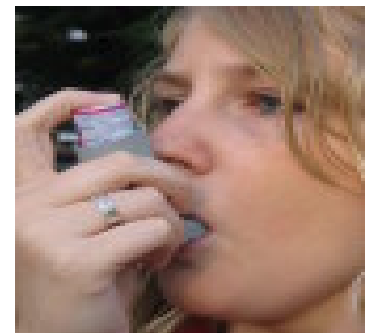


At this town hall meeting, you can:
