Reconvening a Committee

- An ITS Architecture Working Group (Subcommittee) of MOITS was active 2000-2005
- Will now reconvene
 - Will coordinate with jurisdictional efforts
- Tentative schedule: 1st Thursdays (A.M.)
 - Every other month
 - May 4, June 29 (not July 6), Sept. 7, Nov. 2
 - DDOT, MDOT, VDOT, & WMATA will participate; MOITS will be kept informed
 - Other stakeholders welcome

Activities

- Coordinate between regional and jurisdictional architectures
 - Maryland statewide
 - VDOT
 - Others
- Update regional architecture as necessary
- Liaison between USDOT-driven and DHS-driven IT architecture requirements
- Provide forum for architectural consideration of ITS projects
- Identify and facilitate Rule 940 procedures in conjunction with sponsoring jurisdictional practices

Rule 940

- Rule 940 is the USDOT regulation providing policies and procedures under TEA-21 pertaining to conformance with the National Intelligent Transportation Systems Architecture and Standards

- Published 2001, effective 2005
- A systems engineering process must be followed for federally funded ITS projects

Required for ITS projects to be included in the TIP

• Will be the probable topic of a regional ITS workshop tentatively scheduled for June 29
