<u>2010</u>

- September 24 November 8 Public Comment Period (for TMDLs & WIPs)
 COG Comments Submitted to EPA & MD/VA
- Late November early December States/DC Submitted Final Phase I WIPs
- December 29 EPA Issued <u>Final</u> Bay TMDLs in Federal Register
 - Included specific load caps for individual VA stormwater permits

<u>2011</u>

- State coordination with local governments/utilities re: load allocations & Phase II WIPs:
 - MD designated county liaisons; VA using regional planning agencies (e.g., NVRC) Several initial meetings have been held to-date (e.g., NVRC, Maryland counties)
 - District has held its meeting with its Federal stakeholders & will be meeting with local stakeholders
 - MD Considering trading within major basin (e.g., Potomac) & initial/overall county-level reductions
- Agricultural lawsuit submitted/complaints re: EPA: a) exceeded authority, b) based TMDL on flawed assumptions, and c) did not provide sufficient time for public comment
- April 30 EPA distributed *Guide for Federal Lands and Facilities' Role in Chesapeake Bay Jurisdictions' Phase II Watershed Implementation Plans*
- May 9 EPA distributed 2-Year Milestone Guide to the states/District and federal agencies
- June 30 EPA processed two agreed-upon changes to Watershed Model, and <u>proposed</u> nitrogen, phosphorus and sediment allocations for the 19 state-basins (States/District to evaluate them)
- Aug. 1 EPA released <u>finalized</u> nitrogen, phosphorus and sediment allocations for the 19 state-basins, which were 2-3% higher than the original allocations (*two weeks later than original schedule*)

November 1 – States/District submit preliminary 2012-2013 jurisdiction milestone commitments to EPA for scenario analysis (to determine how much milestone commitments will reduce loads)

- December 15– States/District to submit <u>Draft</u> Phase II WIPs to EPA (2 week extension)
 Loads to be sub-allocated to local (county & conservation district) level
- December 31 Bay States must complete first set of 2-Year Milestones
- December EPA to potentially revise TMDLs Based on refined Watershed Model (WSM) updates

<u>2012</u>

- January 3 States/District to submit 2012-2013 jurisdiction milestone commitments to EPA
- February 15 EPA to submit formal comments on draft Phase II WIPs (2 week extension)
- March 30 States/District to submit <u>Final</u> Phase II WIPs to EPA (only 1-1/2 months to finalize)

<u>2017</u>

- Phase III WIPs to be Submitted Draft by June 1, Final by November 1
- EPA to assess <u>implementation</u> progress
 - 60% of WIP Implementation to be Achieved & Ensure practices in place to achieve 2025 goal
- EPA to determine whether appropriate to use additional WSM updates for WIPs & and whether to revise TMDL allocations

<u>2020</u>

• Maryland expects to achieve 100% WIP Implementation

<u>2025</u>

- 100% of WIP Implementation to be Achieved Bay-wide
- EPA could revise TMDL/ propose a Use Attainability Analysis (UAA) to modify the standards used to establish the TMDL (*i.e., if the proposed 'Use' is legally deemed to be not achievable/attainable*)
